**Marine Act 1988**

## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of the Strathbogie Shire Council, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

for the dates and times listed in Table A, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) are prohibited on the waters of the Goulburn River between Sandy Creek and the 5 knot zone near Tahbilk Winery as declared in Item 4(a)(iii) of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No.1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**, excluding –

- (i) vessels involved in the event and maintained in a list by Strathbogie Shire Council;
- (ii) vessels operated by the Strathbogie Shire Council; and
- (iii) vessels transiting the area under supervision.

**SECTION 15 NOTICE**

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Chris Hardman, Regional Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** of the following temporary amendments to Schedule 3 contained in Notice 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

Between the hours of 7.30 am on Saturday 22 November 2008 and 2.00 pm on Saturday 22 November 2008, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Melbourne Head Regatta event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, are prohibited on all the waters of the Yarra River between the upstream edge of the Heyington Rail bridge and the downstream edge of Princes Bridge.

At the completion of the event the waters of the Yarra River will revert to the normal provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
