PROPOSED EDUCATION AND TRAINING REFORM AMENDMENT (AGE REQUIREMENTS) REGULATIONS Preparation of Regulatory Impact Statement

Notice is given in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared in relation to the proposed Education and Training Reform Amendment (Age Requirements) Regulations.

The reason for the proposed regulations is that the existing Education (Prescribed Age) Regulations 1999 will expire in February 2009, and they need to be remade. The existing regulations set the minimum and maximum age limits for enrolment in Victorian Government schools.

The objective of the proposed regulations is to amend the Education and Training Reform Regulations 2007 to provide for the age requirements for enrolment and attendance at Government schools and participation in programs and courses of study at those schools.

The RIS assesses the costs and benefits of the proposed regulations and alternatives. It concludes that the proposed regulations will provide greater public benefits than other alternatives.

Public comments or submissions on the proposed regulations and RIS are invited.
