- 76/2008 (1) Sections 1 and 135 and this section come into operation on the day after the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.  
(2) Subject to subsection (3), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.  
(3) If a provision referred to in subsection (2) does not come into operation before 1 January 2010, it comes into operation on that day.
- 77/2008 This Act comes into operation on 1 November 2009.
- 78/2008 (1) This Part and Division 5 of Part 3 come into operation on the day after the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.  
(2) Subject to subsection (3), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.  
(3) If a provision referred to in subsection (2) does not come into operation before 31 December 2009, it comes into operation on that day.
- 79/2008 (1) This Act (other than sections 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13 and 14 and Part 4) comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.  
(2) Subject to subsection (3), sections 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13 and 14 and Part 4 come into operation on a day to be proclaimed.  
(3) If sections 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13 and 14 and Part 4 do not come into operation before 1 July 2009, they come into operation on that day.
- 80/2008 This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
