ORDER UNDER SECTION 7 VARYING THE PROJECT AREA

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, under section 7 of the **EastLink Project Act 2004** ('the Act'), on the recommendation of the Minister for Roads and Ports and the recommendation of the Minister for Planning, given in accordance with section 7(4) of the Act, varies the Project area, as defined in section 5 of the Act, by making the following changes to the Project area as shown on the relevant LEGL plans identified below and lodged at the Central Plan Office of the Department of Sustainability and Environment:

- a) by adding to the Project area the land shown hatched and described as either 'addition to Project area only', 'addition to Project area and Extended Project area' or 'addition to Project area as defined in stratum' in the Legends, on the plans numbered LEGL./08-102 to LEGL./08-120 (inclusive) and more particularly described by reference to survey plan numbers shown on those plans; and
- b) by excising from the Project area the land shown as hatched and described as 'excise Project area' or 'excise Project area and Extended Project area' in the Legend, on the plans numbered LEGL./08-103, LEGL./08-106 to LEGL./08-107 (inclusive) and LEGL./08-120 and more particularly described by reference to survey plan numbers shown on those plans.

- a) by adding to the Extended Project area the land shown hatched and described as either 'addition to Extended Project area only' or 'addition to Project area and Extended Project area' in the Legends, on the plans numbered LEGL./08-102 to LEGL./08-119 (inclusive) and more particularly described by reference to survey plan numbers shown on those plans; and

SPECIAL

- b) by excising from the Extended Project area the land shown as hatched and described as 'excise Project area and Extended Project area' in the Legends, on the plans numbered LEGL./08-103, LEGL./08-106 to LEGL./08-107 (inclusive) and LEGL./08-120 and more particularly described by reference to survey plan numbers shown on those plans.
