Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Colin McQuillen, Business Support Officer, Southern Rural Water, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

- (1) between 7.00 am and 6.00 pm on Saturday 3 January 2009 bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Glenmaggie and District Boat Racing Event, is prohibited on all the waters of Lake Glenmaggie north-west of an imaginary line between the waters edge at Coongulla Point and the waters edge at Cemetery Point;
- (2) between 7.00 am and 6.00 pm on Saturday 3 January 2009 vessels involved in the Glenmaggie and District Boat Racing Event are excluded from the requirements of Clause 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
- (3) should the event be delayed or interrupted on Saturday 3 January 2009, the event will recommence on Sunday 4 January 2009 and will be subject to clauses 1, 2 and 4 as listed in this notice; and
- (4) at the completion of the event the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 111 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Inspector Stephen Guilmartin, Officer in Charge, Victoria Water Police, hereby give notice under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. vessels associated with the Lifesaving Victoria Carnival Series and Inflatable Rescue Boat Series, being held at the times, dates and locations outlined below in Table 1, are excluded from Clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 4(a) of Notice No. 1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
2. the exemption will be automatically suspended for any periods when swimmers or other vessels not associated with the event approach within 200 metres; and
3. the above provisions will apply only to operators and vessels associated with the event and noted on a list maintained by Lifesaving Victoria.
