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Ambulance Services Act 1986

APPOINTMENT OF DELEGATE TO THE BOARD OF AMBULANCE VICTORIA

Instrument of Appointment

I, Daniel Andrews, Minister for Health, under section 22B of the **Ambulance Services Act 1986** (the Act), appoint Leigh Hocking as a delegate to the Board of Ambulance Victoria.

The appointment is made on the following terms and conditions –

1. Appointment Arrangements

The appointment is part-time.

2. Period of Appointment

The appointment is for a period of 12 months from 1 July 2008.

3. Duties and Responsibilities

Under section 22B of the Act the functions of a delegate to the board of an ambulance service are:

- (a) to attend meetings of the board and observe its decision-making processes; and
- (b) to provide advice or information to the board to assist it in understanding its obligations under the Act relating to the ambulance service; and
- (c) to advise the Minister and the Secretary on any matter relating to the ambulance or the board.

Under section 22D of the Act the obligations of the board of an ambulance service to a delegate are:

- (a) to permit a delegate appointed to the board to attend any meeting of the board; and
- (b) provide a delegate appointed to the board with information or a copy of any notice or other document provided to the directors of the board at the same time as such information, notice or other document is provided to the directors.

4. Payment Provisions

The delegate will be paid remuneration of \$35,640 per annum.

5. Revocation of Appointment

The appointment can be revoked at anytime by the Minister for Health under Section 41A of the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1988**.

6. Superannuation Obligations

Superannuation obligations will be paid in accordance with the Commonwealth's **Superannuation Guarantee Act 1992**.

7. Travel and Personal Expenses

The delegate will be reimbursed for reasonable travel and personal expenses in accordance with the Guidelines for the Provision of Allowances for Travelling and Personal Expenses in the Victorian Public Sector.

8. Leave Arrangements

The delegate will not be entitled to paid leave.
