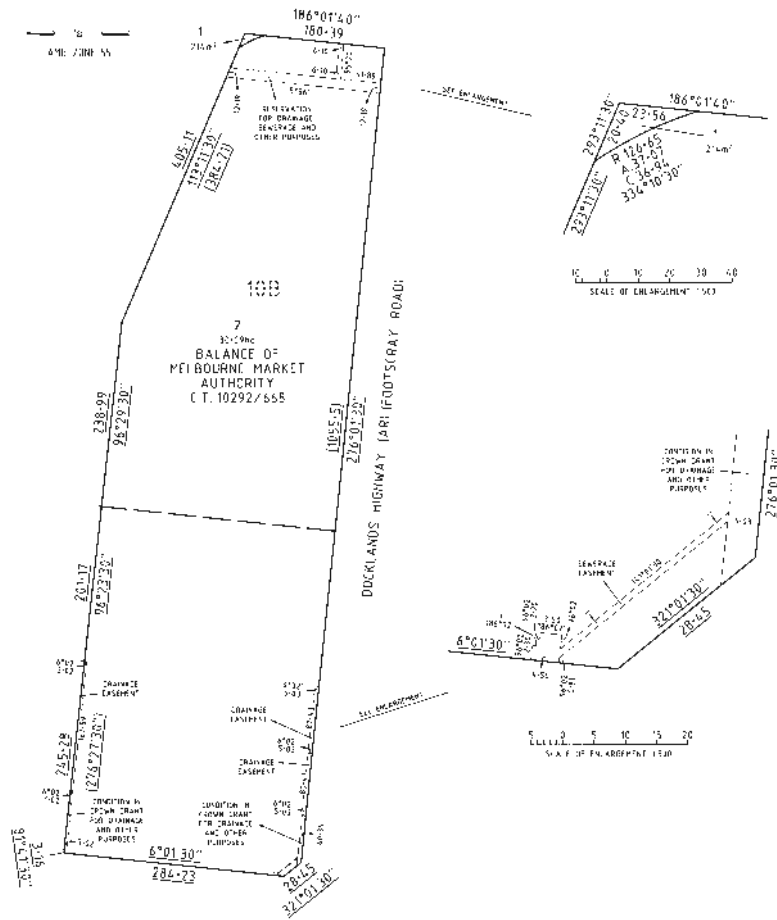
## Project Development and Construction Management Act 1994

### ORDER DIVESTING LAND FROM MELBOURNE MARKET AUTHORITY TO THE CROWN

#### Order in Council

The Governor in Council under section 18(1)(b) of the **Project Development and Construction Management Act 1994** divests Melbourne Market Authority of its interest in land being described as Lot 1 on divestment plan M5044/4B and being part of the land described in Certificate of Title Volume 10292 and Folio 668.

This Order will take effect on the date it is published in the Government Gazette. Upon publication the land will be unalienated Crown land free from all limitations.
