SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Wayne Hill, Manager Local Port Programs, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (the Waterway Manager for 'Waters – ex HMAS Canberra Reserve'), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

1. from 5.00 pm on Friday 20 November 2009 till 5.00 pm Tuesday 1 December 2009 bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring, drifting or allowing a vessel to lie) except those vessels authorised by Parks Victoria is prohibited within 200 metres of the scuttled ex HMAS Canberra in the approximate position Lat 38° 17' 59.94" S, Long 144° 32' 36.08" E. (Yellow lit buoys are located within the exclusion zone.)

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Wayne Hill, Acting Manager, Marine Operations, Bays and Maritime, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** of the following temporary amendments to Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

- (a) between the hours of 6.00 am on Saturday 21 November 2009 and 2.00 pm on Saturday 21 November 2009, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Melbourne Head Regatta event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on all the waters of the Yarra River between the upstream edge of the Heyington Rail Bridge to the downstream edge of Princes Bridge,
- (b) rowing vessels involved in the Melbourne Head Regatta event are excluded from the requirement to wear personal floatation devices as detailed in Schedule 5, made under Regulation 232 of the Marine Regulations 1999,
- (c) vessels involved in the Melbourne Head Regatta event are excluded from the requirement to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots:
 - (a) within 50 meters of the waters edge
as detailed in clause 3(a) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SPECIAL

At the completion of the event the waters of the Yarra River will revert to the normal provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
