MELBOURNE CRICKET GROUND (OPERATION OF FLOODLIGHTS)

DETERMINATION NO. 3/2009

I, James Merlino, Minister for Sport, Recreation and Youth Affairs, make the following determination:

1. Title

This determination may be cited as the Melbourne Cricket Ground (Operation of Floodlights) Determination No. 3/2009.

2. Objectives

The objectives of the determination are to:

- (a) specify a day and time when the floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) may be used; and
- (b) specify the purpose for which the floodlights may be used on that day.

3. Authorising provision

This determination is made under section 30 of the **Melbourne Cricket Ground Act 2009**.

4. Floodlights may be used on certain days at certain times and for certain purposes

The floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground may be used on Thursday 31 December 2009 between 9.30 pm and 10.00 pm for the purpose of assisting with the safe egress of people from Yarra Park following the City of Melbourne's New Year's Eve in the City Family Festival.
