## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Graeme Davis, Acting Manager, Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (the Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the fireworks events and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited for the times, dates and locations as detailed in Table 1.

## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Director, Strategic and Community Development, Shire of Strathbogie (the Waterway Manager for the Goulburn River between Hughes Creek and the Goulburn Weir including the waters of Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. between the hours of between 9 am and 5 pm on Saturday 2 January 2010, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) excluding:
  - (a) vessels and persons involved with events conducted as part of the NOW Festival; and
  - (b) vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie,is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie, south and east of an imaginary line commencing at Huttons Point and extending westerly to the 500 m mark on the rowing course located within the 'un-powered boating zone' described in Item 14 of Schedule 91 and then southerly to the shore;
2. for the area and time detailed above, vessels and persons involved with the events are excluded from the provisions of Clauses 10(a) (5 knot zone), 11 (waterskiing prohibited) and 14 (exclusive use area for unpowered boats) of Schedule 91 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
3. at the completion of event or as determined and announced by the Shire's Group Manager Strategic and Community Development, authorised by the Strathbogie Shire Council, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Director Strategic and Community Development, Strathbogie Shire Council (the Waterway Manager for the Goulburn River between Hughes Creek and the Goulburn Weir including the waters of Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. for the dates, times and locations listed in Table 1, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels:
  - (a) associated with the fireworks event,
  - (b) operated by Strathbogie Shire Council, and
  - (c) that are berthed to the foreshore adjacent to Jacobson's Outlook before 11.30 pm on Thursday 31 December 2009 and not moved until after 12.30 am on Friday 1 January 2010,

is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie.

2. at the completion of the event the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
