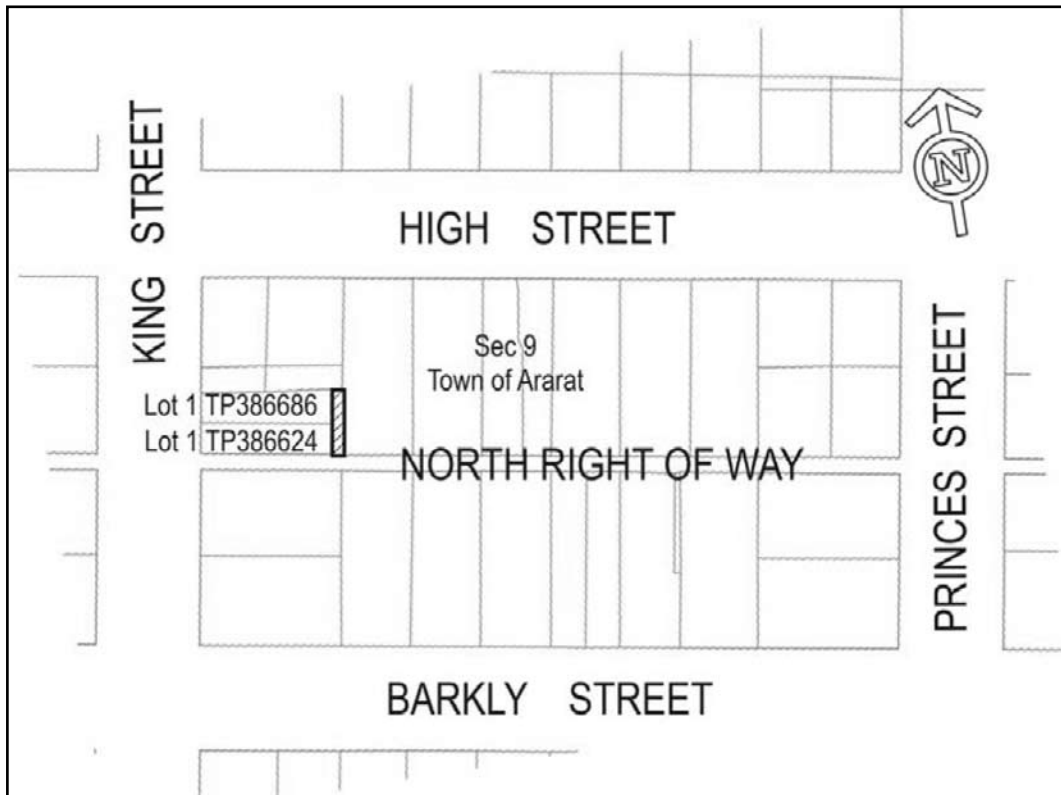

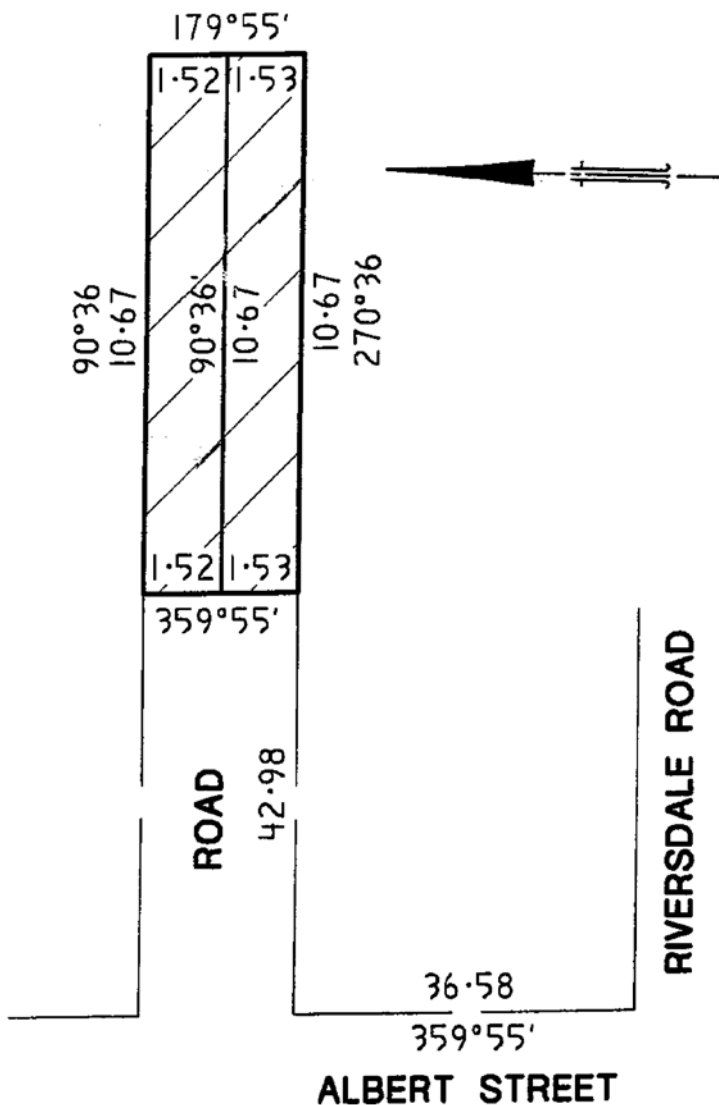

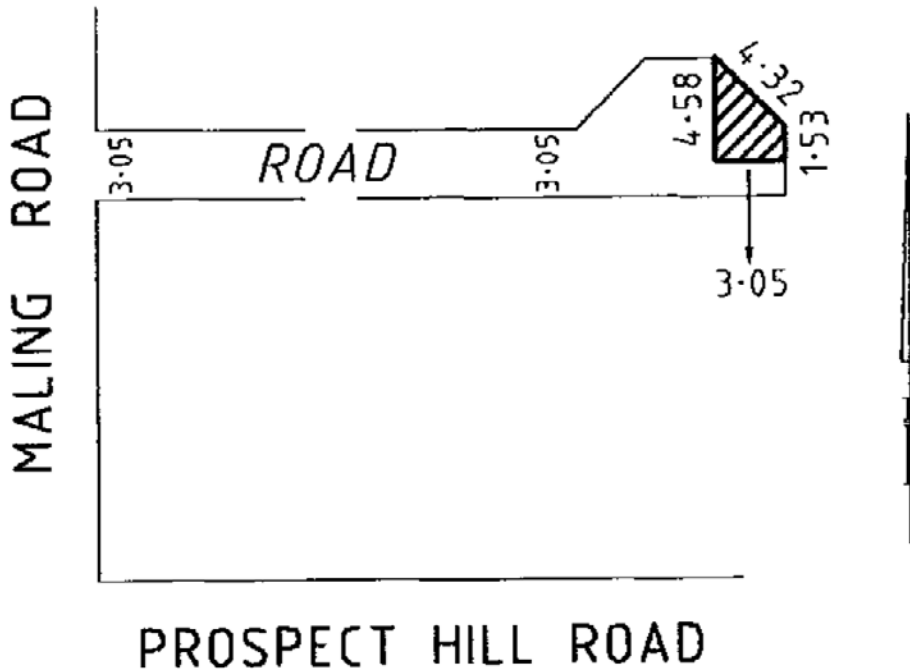

Notice of Preparation of Amendment

Amendment C92

Authorisation A01219

The Darebin City Council has prepared Amendment C92 to the Darebin Planning Scheme, at the request of Meydan Group.

In accordance with section 8A(3) of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987**, the Minister for Planning authorised the Darebin City Council as planning authority to prepare the Amendment.

The land affected by the Amendment is 4, 8, 9–13 and 16–18 Arthurton Road and 17 Elm Street, Northcote.

The Amendment facilitates 'Arthurton Row', a major mixed use project in Arthurton Road, Northcote by:

- rezoning land from Industrial 3 Zone and Residential 1 Zone to Business 2 Zone;
- applying the Environmental Audit Overlay to the land;
- applying the Development Plan Overlay (DPO10) to the land;
- replacing the Schedule to the Business 2 Zone to restrict the combined floor area for a shop;
- inserting a new Schedule 10 (Arthurton Row) to the Development Plan Overlay to guide the future use and development of the land; and
- replacing the Schedule to Clause 61.03.

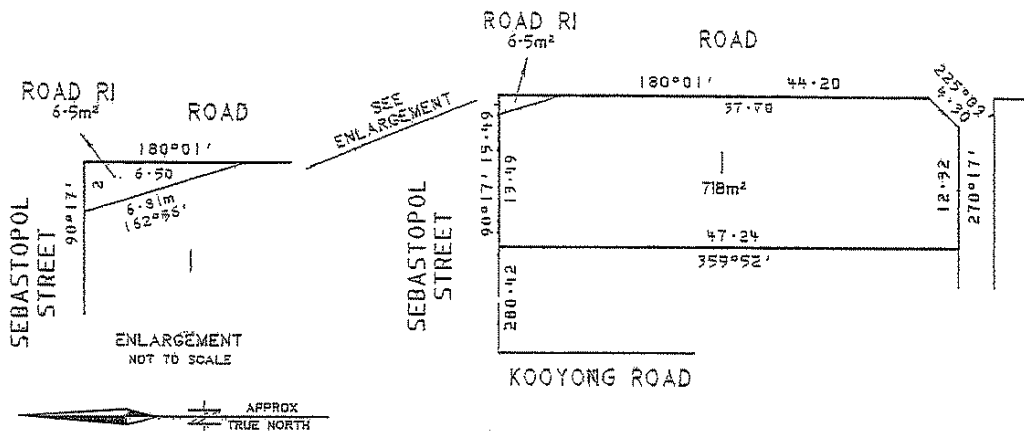

The Essential Services Commission (ESC) is currently conducting a review of the economic regulation of Victoria's ports pursuant to section 53(2) of the **Ports Services Act 1995** (PSA). - in making recommendations about the regulation of Victorian ports, including pricing and access regulation the ESC should have regard to the principles outlined in clauses 4.1 and 4.2 of the Competition and Infrastructure Reform Agreement;
- the ESC is to assess whether the Channels Access Regime is necessary in order to ensure competition or competitive tension in upstream and/or downstream markets;
- if it considers there is a net benefit from continuing the Victorian Channels Access Regime, the ESC should assess whether the regime in its current form is able to be certified by the National Competition Council, or if not, assess what changes would render it able to be certified; and
- the ESC should take particular note of recent amendments to the ESC Act, in particular, the insertion of Part 3A and the implications of this for the design and assessment of access regimes.

These additional matters referred to the ESC by the Minister will be addressed in the ESC's current review.

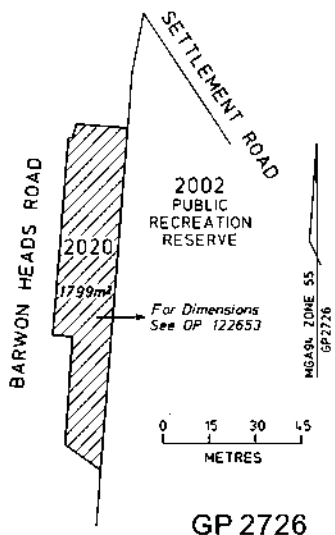


TOTAL AREA OF HATCHED PORTIONS 1101m²

Date of Effect

1. This Order is effective from the date it is published in the Government Gazette.

Definitions

2. In this Order:

‘**Act**’ means the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003**;

‘**approved venue**’ has the meaning given in section 1.3 of the Act;

‘**allocation process**’ means the process for allocating gaming machine entitlements determined by the Minister pursuant to a proposed amendment to Chapter 3 of the Act;

‘**gaming machine**’ has the meaning given in section 1.3 of the Act;

‘**gaming machine entitlement**’ means an entitlement which authorises a venue operator to acquire a gaming machine and to conduct gaming on a gaming machine in an approved venue, which is proposed to be created under a proposed amendment to Chapter 3 of the Act;

‘**monitoring licence**’ means a licence to operate and maintain an electronic monitoring system to monitor gaming machines and associated equipment and systems, which is proposed to be created under a proposed amendment to Part 4 of Chapter 3 of the Act;

‘**protected information**’ has the meaning given in section 10.1.29 of the Act;

‘**relevant entity**’ has the meaning given in section 10.2A.1 of the Act;

‘**Review Panel**’ means the Review Panel established under section 10.2A.2 of the Act; and

‘**venue operator**’ has the meaning given in section 1.3 of the Act.

Referral of Matters to Review Panel

3. The Governor in Council refers the following matters to the Review Panel for consideration and report to the Minister:

- vi) there has been any improper interference with the allocation process or the allocation of gaming machine entitlements or with any recommendation or report to the Minister by a relevant entity with respect to the allocation of gaming machine entitlements; and
 - vii) if any recommendations or reports to the Minister have been prepared by a relevant entity in relation to the allocation of gaming machine entitlements, the preparation of a recommendation or report discloses bias or anything that could lead to a reasonable apprehension of bias; and
- b) with respect to the grant of a monitoring licence, whether:
- i) all registrants and applicants for the monitoring licence have been treated equally and impartially and have been given the same opportunity to access information and advice about the process of granting a monitoring licence;
 - ii) all protected information has been managed to ensure its security and confidentiality;
 - iii) all registrants and applicants referred to in subparagraph (i) have been evaluated in a systematic manner against explicit predetermined evaluation criteria;
 - iv) every relevant entity involved in the process of granting a monitoring licence has been required to declare any actual or perceived conflict of interest before participating in the process;
 - v) any conflict of interest referred to in subparagraph (iv) has been appropriately addressed;
 - vi) there has been any improper interference with the making of a report or recommendation by a relevant entity to the Minister; and
 - vii) the preparation of a recommendation or report discloses bias or anything that could lead to a reasonable apprehension of bias.

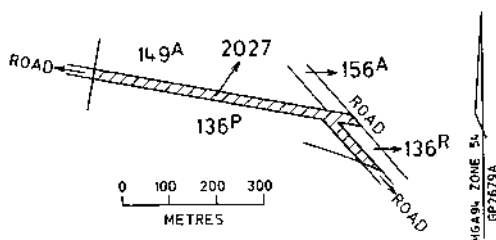


TOTAL AREA OF HATCHED PORTIONS 5945m²

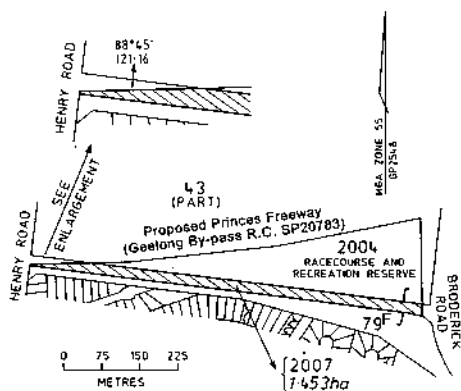

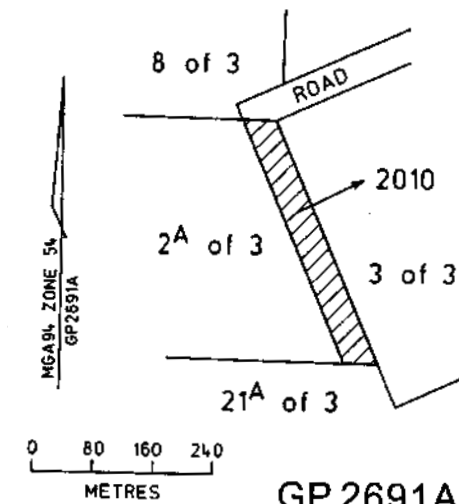
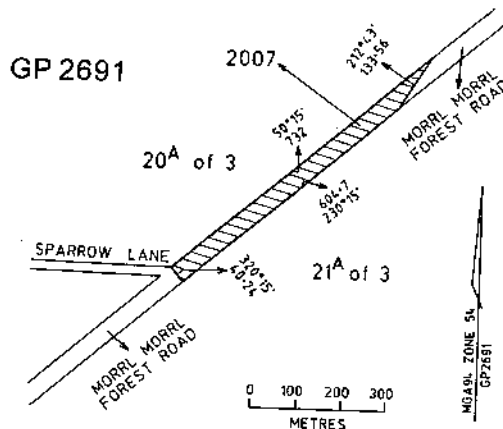

‘**Potato Cyst nematode**’ or ‘**PCN**’ means the pest *Globodera rostochiensis* (Wollenweber) Skarbilovich;

‘**PCN host plants**’ means any plant or plant product of the Solanaceae family and any root vegetable, bulb, seedling, nursery plant or tree;

‘**Solanaceae**’ means the family of plants which includes potatoes, tomatoes, eggplants, and weeds including nightshade;

‘**the Act**’ means the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

2 Prohibitions relating to the control areas

(1) The removal from the control areas of –

- (a) PCN host plants; or
- (b) agricultural equipment; or
- (c) packages, including bins or bulk bags, which contain, or have contained, any PCN host plants; or
- (d) soil –
is prohibited.

(2) Sub-clause (1) does not apply in the case of –

- (a) nursery plants, including seedlings, grown in soil-less media; or
- (b) bare-rooted plants; or
- (c) root vegetables (except potatoes) or bulbs which have been washed or brushed so as to be free of visible soil.

Note: Section 9(3) provides a penalty of 100 penalty units for a person who contravenes any prohibition or restriction in a control order if the person knows or has reason to believe that any place has been declared to be a control area, unless the person is authorised to do so under a permit issued by the Secretary.

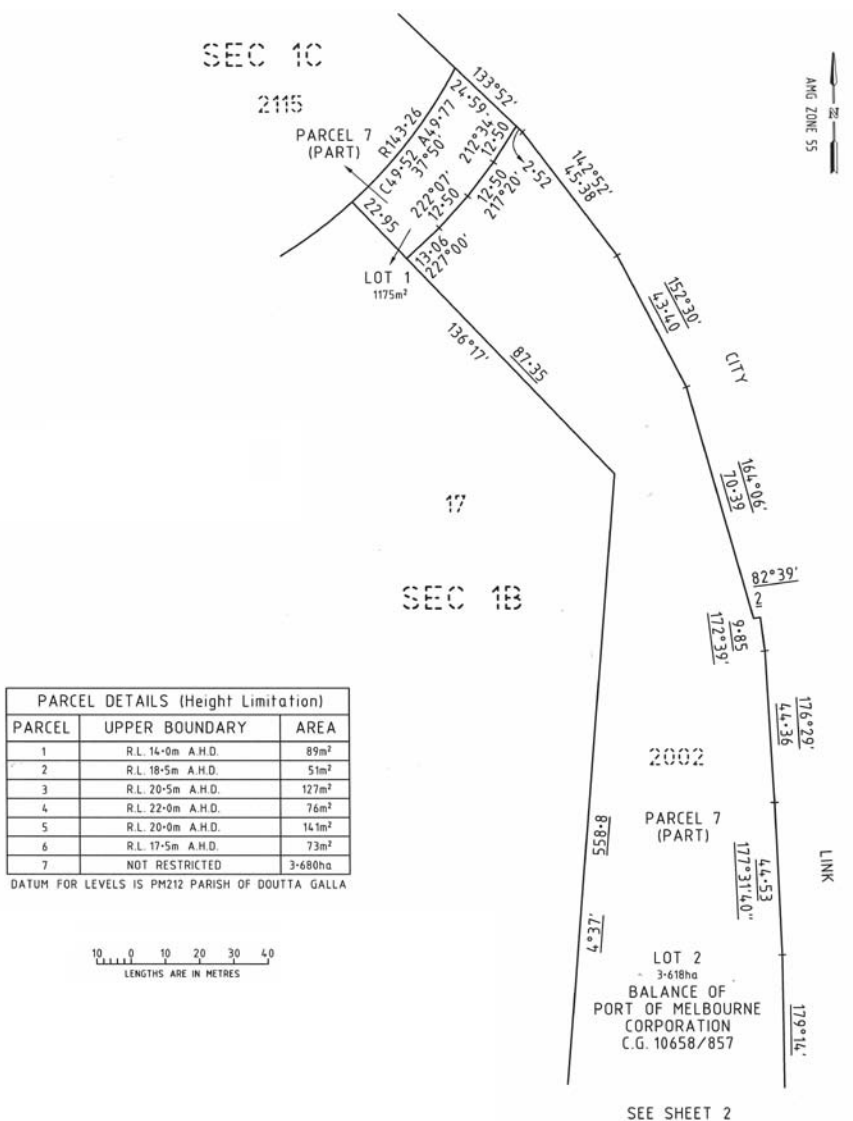
