## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Brian Riches, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Mal Poulter, Acting Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

- (a) between the hours of 6.00 am and 6.00 pm Sunday 8 March 2009, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding those vessels involved with the 2009 Melbourne International Dragon Boat Festival is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River within the area detailed below in **Table 1**.

**Table 1: Victoria Harbour Exclusion Zone**

The waters bounded by:

- (i) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 7.0032 S, 144° 56' 22.2684 E to a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 1.9164 S, 144° 56' 41.802 E;
- (ii) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 1.9164 S, 144° 56' 41.802 E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 3.8676 S, 144° 56' 42.3888 E;
- (iii) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 41' 3.8676 S, 144° 56' 42.3888 E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 8.8176 S, 144° 56' 22.9344 E;
- (iv) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 8.8176 S, 144° 56' 22.9344 E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 7.0032 S, 144° 56' 22.2684 E

- (b) at the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

**SECTION 15 NOTICE**

I, Brian Riches, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Director Strategic and Community Development, Strathbogie Shire Council hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

1. between the hours of 8.00 am and 5.00 pm Saturday 7 March 2009, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie south and east of an imaginary line commencing at Huttons Point, and extending westerly to the 500 metre mark on the rowing course located within the unpowered boating zone as described in item 14 of Schedule 91, and then southerly to the shore, excluding –
  - (a) vessels and persons involved with events conducted as part of the Nagambie on Water Festival; and
  - (b) vessels escorted along the southern and western boundary of the exclusion zone; and
  - (c) vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie.
2. for the areas and times listed above vessels involved with the Nagambie on Water Festival are excluded from Clauses 3(a), 7, of Notice 1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** and Item 10(a) of Schedule 91 of Notice 1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
3. at the completion of event, or as determined and announced by the Shire's Group Manager Strategic and Community Development, authorised by the Strathbogie Shire Council, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

**SECTION 15 NOTICE**

I, Brian Riches, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Director Strategic and Community Development, Strathbogie Shire Council hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that –

1. between the hours of 8.00 am and 4.30 pm Tuesday 10 March 2009 the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie in the western 750 metres of the unpowered boating zone as described in item 14 of Schedule 91, excluding –
  - (a) vessels and persons involved in the Catholic All Schools Triathlon or involved with management and safety; and
  - (b) vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie.
2. at the completion of event, or as determined and announced by the Shire's Group Manager Strategic and Community Development, authorised by the Strathbogie Shire Council, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
