Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Acting Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Group Manager Strategic and Community Development, Strathbogie Shire Council, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

1. from 8.00 am till 5.00 pm Saturday 16 May 2009 the operation of vessels is prohibited on all the waters of Lake Nagambie south east of an imaginary line between the waters edge adjacent to the prolongation of Racecourse Road and the northern point of Vickers Island excluding –
 - (a) vessels involved with the State Masters Rowing Regatta; and
 - (b) vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie; and
 - (c) vessels launching from and returning to the Nagambie Lake Leisure Park boat ramp and adjacent foreshore providing that they:
 - (i) travel directly to and from the Goulburn River entrance north of Vickers island; and
 - (ii) travel to the west of Dellah Island; and
 - (iii) do not exceed 5 knots on the above waters on Lake Nagambie.
2. vessels involved in the State Masters Rowing Regatta and vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie are exempt from clauses 2 a, 2c, 3a and 3b of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
3. at the completion of an event or as determined and announced by the Shire's Group Manager Strategic and Community Development, authorised by the Strathbogie Shire Council, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
