ROAD SAFETY (VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 1999

Notice Declaring Sideways Force Coefficient Routine Investigation Machines to be Class 3 Vehicles

Regulation 515(2) of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1999 provides that the Roads Corporation may by notice published in the Government Gazette declare a category of vehicles to be class 3 vehicles.

Clause 39 and Clause 40 of Schedule 3 to the Regulations provides that the mass and dimension limits for a vehicle in a category of vehicles declared by the Corporation under Regulation 515(2) are the relevant mass and dimension limits for that vehicle set out in Division 1 and 2 of Part 4 of the Regulations except to the extent that the Corporation specifies otherwise in the declaration.

In accordance with Regulation 515(2), I, George Mavroyeni, delegate of the Roads Corporation, declare that a Sideways Force Coefficient Routine Investigation Machine is a class 3 vehicle if:

- a) the vehicle has no more than two axles; and
- b) the vehicle is fitted with equipment for the testing and assessment of the skid resistance of road surfaces; and
- c) any load of water is for the sole purpose of testing and assessment of the skid resistance of road surfaces; and
- d) the mass on the rear axle does not exceed 10.0 tonnes; and
- e) the rear overhang of the vehicle does not exceed 2.20 metres.

I further declare that the mass and dimension limits of this vehicle do not include the limits set out in Division 1 and 2 of Part 4 of the Regulations to the extent that they are inconsistent with the above requirements.

This notice operates from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette until 29 July 2010.
