Gambling Regulation Act 2003

SECTION 3.2.4

Determination by the Victorian Commission for Gambling Regulation of the Maximum Permissible Number of Gaming Machines Available for Gaming in Municipal Districts

Under section 3.2.4(1)(b)(ii) of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** the Victorian Commission for Gambling Regulation has determined, in accordance with the criteria specified in the Minister for Gaming's order on 19 June 2009, the maximum permissible number of gaming machines available for gaming in each municipal district in Victoria.

The maximum permissible number of gaming machines available in each municipal district is as follows:

Under section 3.2.4(1)(c)(ii) of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** the Victorian Commission for Gambling Regulation has also determined, in accordance with the criteria specified in the Minister for Gaming's order on 19 June 2009, how gaming machines are to be removed from a municipal district if the number of gaming machines in that municipal district exceeds the maximum permissible number.

The gaming machines to be removed from municipal districts where the number of gaming machines in that municipal district exceeds the maximum permissible number is as follows:
