In granting this exemption, the Tribunal noted:

- Wannik, the Victorian Government’s education strategy for Koorie students outlines that the Koorie support workforce, which already plays a vital role in engaging families and supporting Koorie young people in early childhood and through their schooling, will be reformed and expanded.
- The position descriptions for Koorie Education Development Officer, Koorie Educator and Koorie Home School Liaison Officer remain substantially unchanged and continue to involve extensive consultation with the Koorie community. In the case of Koorie Educators, support of Koorie students in the classroom is required on a daily basis. Koorie Education Development Officers, Koorie Home School Liaison Officers, and to a lesser extent Koorie Educators, involve extensive consultation with the Koorie community and support of student attendance through close family engagement.
- The new Koorie Education Coordinator will lead the regional Koorie Student Support Team in the implementation of Wannik. The Koorie Education Coordinator will have a high level understanding of the current education and early childhood development reform agenda, particularly as it relates to Koorie students and the broader Koorie community. The Koorie Education Coordinator will have a proven record of working with and a high level understanding of the Koorie community, Koorie culture and Koorie education issues.
- Koorie communities remain more receptive to the provision of information delivered by Koorie Support Workforce as communication is both culturally relevant and based on a common set of experiences and understandings of issues impacting on Koorie young people. In particular, the Koorie Support Workforce is able to demonstrate sensitivities when working with the Koorie community that take into account both family and community experiences.

The Tribunal hereby grants an exemption to the applicant from the operation of sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to engage in the specified conduct.

- He frequently needs to be removed from class for disruptive behaviour and requires one to one supervision when this occurs.
- It is an Occupational Health and Safety issue, as it is very difficult to provide a safe work environment for staff, most of whom are female, and for our student population, without a male education support person.
- The school meets frequently with the family, Protective Services and other support agencies and all acknowledge the high level of support required by the student. Despite weekly counselling sessions at the school his behaviour has continued to escalate.
- The student needs intensive supervision at all times.

The Tribunal hereby grants an exemption to the applicant from the operation of sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to advertise for and employ a male Education Support person.
