## Marine Act 1988

### SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Darren Schultz, Building and Contracts Officer, Loddon Shire Council, the Waterway Manager for the Loddon River (at Bridgewater between the Flour Mill Weir and Sweenys Lane), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (a) from 6.00 pm Friday 29 January 2010 till 8.00 pm Sunday 31 January 2010, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Australian Masters Water Skiing Competition, is prohibited on all the waters of the Loddon River at Bridgewater, between the Flour Mill Weir and Sweenys Lane;
- (b) vessels involved in the Australian Masters Water Skiing Competition are excluded from the requirements of clauses 2(1), 2(2)(a), and 5 as contained in Schedule 62 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**; and
- (c) at the completion of the event the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 62 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

## Marine Act 1988

### SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Dianne Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Vin Wright, Operations Manager, Bays and Marine, Parks Victoria, (the Waterway Manager for the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. from 8.00 pm till 10.30 pm Monday 25 January 2010, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Audi Victoria Week, Bay FM Fireworks Event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited within 200 metres of a fireworks barge located on Corio Bay in the approximate position 38° 08' 24.70" S, 144° 22' 0.11" E (approximately 400 metres north of the Geelong Waterfront, between Cunningham Pier and the Royal Geelong Yacht Club); and
2. at the completion of the event the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 1, contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
