## Marine Act 1988

### SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Geoff Barrow, Ranger in Charge Wangaratta, Parks Victoria (the Waterway Manager for Lake Moodemere), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (1) between 6.00 am and 6.00 pm on Friday 8 January, Saturday 9 January and Sunday 10 January 2010, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Murray River Rowing Association Annual Regatta, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Moodemere;
- (2) between 6.00 am and 6.00 pm on Friday 8 January, Saturday 9 January and Sunday 10 January 2010, vessels involved in the Murray Rowing Association Annual Regatta are excluded from the requirements of Clause 2(c) and Clause 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**; and
- (3) at the completion of the event the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 129 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

## Marine Act 1988

### SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Director Strategic and Community Development, Strathbogie Shire Council (the Waterway Manager for the Goulburn River between Hughes Creek and the Goulburn Weir including the waters of Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. for the periods and times listed in Table 1 the operation of vessels is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie south-east of an imaginary line between the waters edge adjacent to the prolongation of Racecourse Road and the northern point of Vickers Island excluding:
  - (a) vessels involved with the events listed in the Table 1. of this Notice; and
  - (b) vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie; and
  - (c) vessels launching from and returning to the Nagambie Lake Leisure Park boat ramp and adjacent foreshore providing that they:
    - (i) do not exceed 5 knots;
    - (i) travel directly to and from the Goulburn River entrance north of Vickers Island keeping to the west of Dellah Island; and
  - (d) vessels travelling to and from the Goulburn River from Willow Grove and passing under the Scour Bridge providing they do not exceed 5 knots.

2. During the closure periods as listed in Table 1 competitors' rowing vessels are prohibited from operating on the waters of the Goulburn River.
3. At the completion of an event on any of the days detailed in the table or as determined and announced by the Shire's Group Manager Strategic and Community Development (authorised by the Strathbogie Shire Council), the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
