DECLARATION OF CERTAIN ANIMALS TO BE PROHIBITED PEST ANIMALS, CONTROLLED PEST ANIMALS, REGULATED PEST ANIMALS OR ESTABLISHED PEST ANIMALS

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister for Environment and Climate Change under sections 64 to 67 of the **Catchment and Land Protection Act 1994** (the Act), declares:

- (i) under section 58(1)(b) of the Act the animals listed in Schedule 1 to be prohibited pest animals for the whole of the State of Victoria; and
- (ii) under section 58(1)(b) of the Act the animals listed in Schedule 2 to be controlled pest animals for the whole of the State of Victoria; and
- (iii) under section 58(1)(b) of the Act the animals listed in Schedule 3 to be regulated pest animals for the whole of the State of Victoria; and
- (iv) under section 58(1)(b) of the Act the animals listed in Schedule 4A to be established pest animals for the whole of the State of Victoria; and
- (v) under sections 58(1)(b) and 59(5) of the Act the feral or wild population of the animals listed in Schedule 4B to be established pest animals for the whole of the State of Victoria.

DECLARATION OF DINGO TO BE UNPROTECTED WILDLIFE

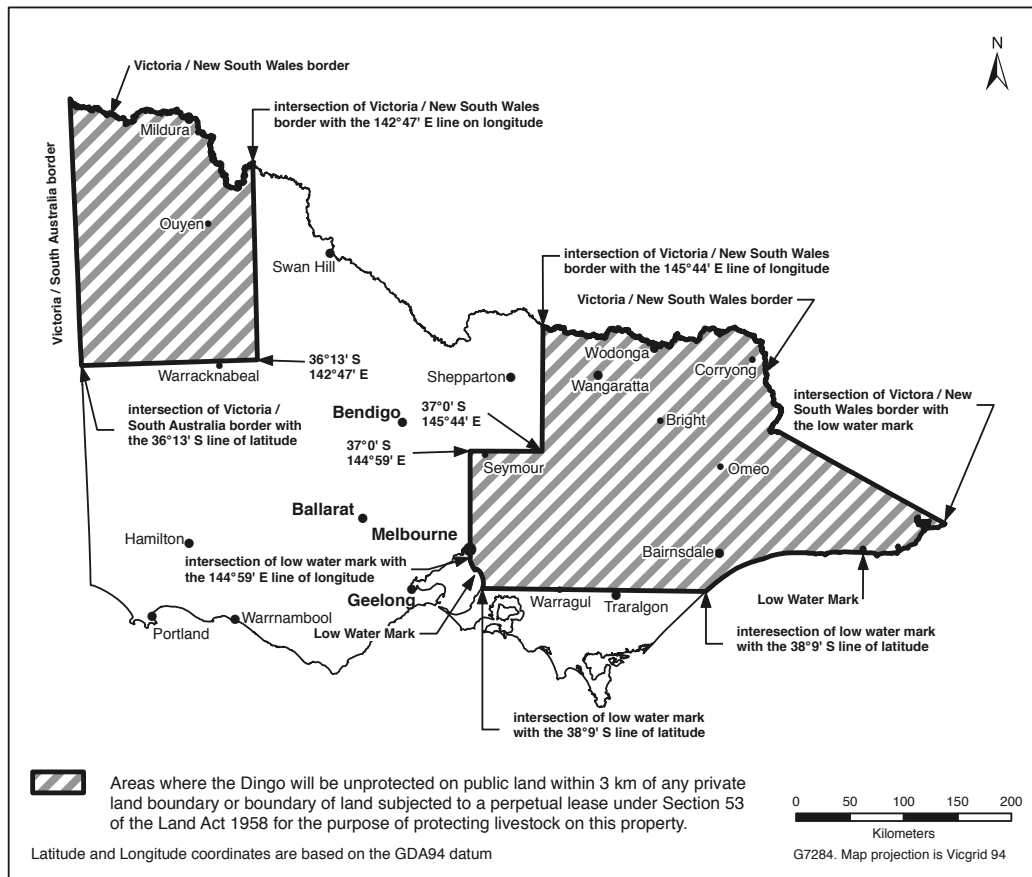
Order in Council

The Governor in Council, under Section 7A of the **Wildlife Act 1975**, declares the Dingo (*Canis lupus subsp Dingo*), except when kept in captivity, unprotected wildlife on:

- (a) all private land in Victoria; and
- (b) public land within 3 km of any private land boundary in the land shown hatched in Schedule 1 of the proposed Order in Council; and
- (c) public land within 3 km of a boundary of land subjected to a perpetual lease under section 53 of the **Land Act 1958** for the purpose of protecting livestock shown hatched in Schedule 1 of the proposed Order in Council,

for a period of three years from the day that the Order in Council is published in the Government Gazette; and in accordance with the conditions, restrictions and limitations specified in Schedule 2.

SCHEDULE 2

Conditions, Restrictions and Limitations

1. Where unprotected, the Dingo can be taken or killed by the below methods:
 - (a) traps and other device that comply with standards set in The Prevention of Animal Cruelty Regulations 2008;
 - (b) Poisoned with registered baits in accordance with the **Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Act 1994 (Victoria)**; or
 - (c) Firearms in accordance with the **Firearms Act 1996**; and
2. In the case of private land described in this Order, there are no restrictions on who may kill or take a Dingo; and
3. In the case of public land within 3 km of any:
 - (i) private land boundary; and
 - (i) boundary of land subjected to a perpetual lease under section 53 of the **Land Act 1958** for the purpose of protecting livestock on this property,described in this Order, employees of, and persons engaged to kill or take Dingoes in writing by, the Department of Sustainability and Environment, the Department of Primary Industries or Parks Victoria may kill or take a Dingo.
