SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Graeme Davis, Acting Manager, Marine Operations, Bays and Maritime, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** of the following temporary amendments to Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Between the hours of 6.00 am on Saturday 20 November 2010 and 2.00 pm on Saturday 20 November 2010, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Melbourne Head Regatta event, vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria and vessels authorised by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on all the waters of the Yarra River between the upstream edge of the Monash Freeway Bridge to the downstream edge of Princes Bridge.
2. Rowing vessels involved in the Melbourne Head Regatta event are excluded from the requirement to wear personal floatation devices as detailed in Schedule 5, made under Regulation 232 of the Marine Regulations 2009.
3. Vessels involved in the Melbourne Head Regatta event are excluded from the requirement to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within 50 meters of the waters edge as detailed in clause 3(a) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
4. At the completion of the event the waters of the Yarra River will revert to the normal provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Vin Wright, Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (the Waterway Manager for the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Between the hours of 12.00 midday and 5.00 pm Saturday 20 November 2010, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Geelong Gala Day Water Ski Show and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on the waters of Corio Bay within the area detailed below in Table 1.

Table 1: Corio Bay Exclusion Zone

The waters bounded by:

- (a) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 144° 21' 51.06" E, 38° 08' 34.50" S to a marker buoy located in approximate position 144° 21' 43.93" E, 38° 08' 34.90" S;
- (b) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 144° 21' 43.93" E, 38° 08' 34.90" S to a marker buoy in approximate position 144° 21' 52.84" E, 38° 08' 30.11" S;
- (c) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 144° 21' 52.84" E, 38° 08' 30.11" S to a point on the shore 144° 21' 52.84" E, 38° 08' 32.28" S;
- (c) A line extending from a point on the shore 144° 21' 52.84" E, 38° 08' 32.28" S to a point on the shore 144° 21' 52.84" E, 38° 08' 32.28" S;
- (d) A line extending from a point on the shore 144° 21' 52.84" E, 38° 08' 32.28" S to a point on the shore 144° 21' 52.84" E, 38° 08' 32.59" S;
- (e) A line extending from a point on the shore 144° 21' 52.84" E, 38° 08' 32.59" S to a point on the shore 144° 21' 51.06" E, 38° 08' 34.50" S.

2. Between the hours of 12.00 midday and 5.00 pm on Saturday 20 November 2010 vessels involved in the Geelong Gala Day Water Ski Show and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria are excluded from the requirements of:
 - (a) Clause 2(a) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**; and
 - (b) Clause 2(c) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**; and
 - (c) Clause 4(a) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

3. At the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 1 contained in Notice No. 1 under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
