Road Safety Act 1986

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 68(4) OF THE **ROAD SAFETY ACT 1986** THAT CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE **ROAD SAFETY ACT 1986** DO NOT APPLY WITH RESPECT TO THE SHEPPARTON SPRING CAR NATIONALS

1. Purpose

The purpose of this notice is to make a declaration under section 68(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** that, subject to the limitations and conditions specified in this notice, sections 68(1) and 68(2) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** do not apply to persons participating in the Spring Car Nationals from 26 to 28 November 2010, to be held primarily at the Shepparton Showgrounds.

2. Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 68(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 68(4) provides that the Minister for Roads and Ports may, on the application of an organisation and by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that sections 68(1) and 68(2) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** do not apply with respect to any function or event that is organised and conducted by that organisation.

Section 68(1) provides that it is an offence for a person to drive or be in charge of a motor vehicle which is being used in a race or speed trial on a highway. Section 68(2) makes it an offence for a person, alone or with any other person, to organise or manage a race or speed trial or to carry out or cause to be carried out any preparations for the conduct of a race or speed trial that is held or to be held on a highway.

Section 65A(5) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** states that section 65A(1) (which prohibits a person from driving a motor vehicle in a manner which causes the motor vehicle to undergo loss of traction) does not apply to a person participating in an event subject to a notice under section 68(4).

3. Commencement

This notice comes into operation on 26 November 2010.

4. Expiry

This notice expires at midnight on 28 November 2010.

5. Declaration

In accordance with section 68(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**, I, Steve Brown, as delegate for the Minister for Roads and Ports and on the application of the Greater Shepparton City Council as the event organiser, declare that sections 68(1) and 68(2) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** do not apply with respect to the Spring Car Nationals, to be held from 26 to 28 November 2010, provided that all safety and other requirements determined by the event organiser are complied with.

THE MOUNT BULLER KING OF THE MOUNTAIN CHALLENGE EVENT

1. Purpose

The purpose of this notice is to make a declaration under section 68(3) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** that, subject to the limitations and conditions specified in this notice, sections 68(1) and 68(2) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and the Road Safety Road Rules 2009 (other than the provisions specified in column one of Schedule 1) do not apply to the Mount Buller King of the Mountain Challenge Event on 26 and 27 November 2010.

2. Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 68(3) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 68(3) provides that the Minister for Roads and Ports may by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that sections 68(1) and 68(2) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of any regulations (except as specified in the notice) do not apply with respect to a race or speed trial held on a specified highway between specified times.

Section 68(1) provides that it is an offence for a person to drive or be in charge of a motor vehicle which is being used in a race or speed trial on a highway. Section 68(2) makes it an offence for a person, alone or with any other person, to organise or manage a race or speed trial or to carry out or cause to be carried out any preparations for the conduct of a race or speed trial that is held or to be held on a highway.

3. Commencement

This notice takes effect on 26 November 2010.

4. Expiry

This notice expires at midnight on 27 November 2010.

5. Declaration

In accordance with section 68(3) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**, I, Steve Brown, as delegate for the Minister for Roads and Ports declare that sections 68(1) and 68(2) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and the Road Safety Road Rules 2009 (other than the provisions specified in column one of Schedule 1) do not apply to participants in or organisers of the Mount Buller King of the Mountain Challenge Event, at the locations and between the times specified in Schedule 2, provided that the event is conducted in full compliance with all safety and other requirements determined by the event organiser and any permit issued by the Roads Corporation.
