### SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of David Jackson, Land and On-Water Manager, Goulburn Murray Water (Waterway Manager for the waters of Lake Eildon and Eildon Pondage), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that from 12.00 pm Friday 5 November 2010 until further notice Clause 1(q) of Schedule 90 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** is amended to read:

The following waters of Lake Eildon are subject to a 5 knot speed restriction:

- (q) *Goulburn Inlet* – South of a line of buoys stating ‘5 knots’ in the vicinity of Taylor Road, Jamieson.

### SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Bernard Blood, Curator Lake Wendouree, City of Ballarat (the Waterway Manager for Lake Wendouree), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels authorised by the City of Ballarat, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Wendouree bounded by the geo spatially referenced points detailed in Table 1. The exclusion zone will remain in operation until 14 December 2010.

**SECTION 15 NOTICE**

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Inspector Stephen Guilmartin, Officer in Charge, Water Police Squad – Search and Rescue Squad (member of the Victoria Police) hereby give notice under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

1. from 1.00 pm to 4.00 pm on Sunday 7 November 2010 bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding Police vessels and Port of Melbourne security vessels, is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River, 30 metres off the bank between:
  - (a) 50 metres upstream of the Port Education Centre boundary, and
  - (b) 50 metres downstream of the Port Education Centre boundary.
