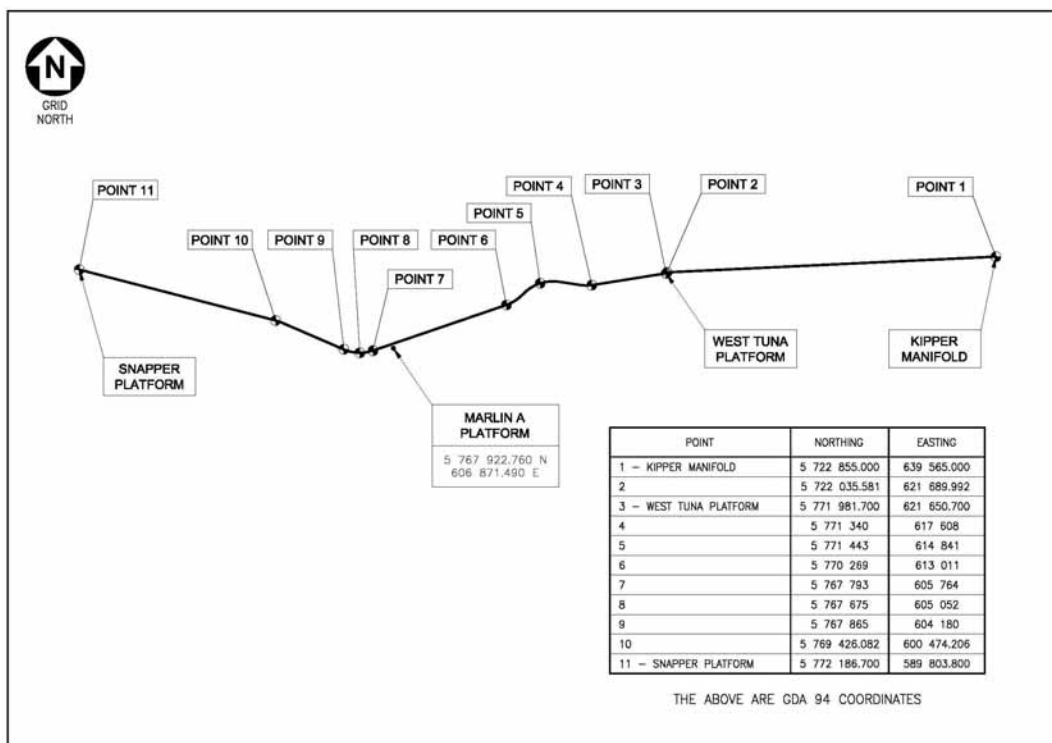
COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA

Prohibition of Entry into a Safety Zone – Kipper Tuna Turrum (VIC/PL39, VIC/PL40 and VIC/PL41)

I, Terry McKinley, Manager Petroleum Operations Safety and Environment of Department of Primary Industries of Victoria, pursuant to section 616 of the **Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage Act 2006**, hereby prohibit all vessels other than vessels under the control of the registered holders of Pipeline Licence Nos. VIC/PL39, VIC/PL40 and VIC/PL41, and vessels operated by authorised persons who are exercising powers under section 615(1) of Division 1 of Part 6.6 of the above Act from entering or remaining in the area of the safety zone without the consent in writing from the Victorian Department of Primary Industries.

This safety zone:

- extends to a distance of 500 metres measured from each point of the outer edge of vessels 'DB 30', 'Miclyn Endurance', all vessels operated by McDermott Australia Pty Ltd (MAPL) and those under the control of the registered operator.
- is centred at the actual position of the vessels which will travel along the coordinates in the table below for a period to commence on 10 November 2010 and to expire on 28 February 2011.



The sequence of pipe lay is as follows. Two pipelines (northern and southern) will be installed within the alignment provided commencing at West Tuna Platform and ending at Kipper Manifold. On completion of the two pipelines from West Tuna Platform to Kipper Manifold pipe-lay operations will install a single pipeline within the alignment described commencing at West Tuna Platform via Marlin A ending at Snapper Platform.

SPECIAL

Where an unauthorised vessel enters or remains in the safety zone specified in contravention of this instrument, the owner and the person in command or in charge of the vessel are each guilty of an offence against section 616 of the Act and are punishable, upon conviction, by imprisonment for a term:

- not exceeding 15 years if the breach is determined as intentional.
- not exceeding 12.5 years if the breach is determined as recklessness.
- not exceeding 10 years if the breach is determined as negligence.
- not exceeding 5 years if the breach is determined as an offence of strict liability.
