### ROAD SAFETY (VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 2009

#### Specification of Temporary Routes for Class 1 Vehicles

**1. Purpose**

The purpose of this notice is to specify certain routes on which Class 1 vehicles may travel in order to detour the temporary road closures for the Yea Market Event and Celebrations.

**2. Authorising provision**

This notice is made under regulation 178 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009.

**3. Commencement**

This notice comes into operation at 9.00 am on 3 December 2010.

**4. Expiration**

This notice expires at 9.00 am on 4 December 2010.

**6. Declaration**

I, Don Hogben, delegate of the Roads Corporation, declare that a class 1 vehicle that is a load carrying vehicle or combination, a special purpose vehicle or an agricultural vehicle, or a vehicle operating under permit issued under regulation 180 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009 may, on the conditions specified in that permit, travel on the routes and at the times specified in the Table below –
