SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Acting Chief Executive Officer, Strathbogie Shire Council (Waterway Manager for the Waters of the Goulburn River from Hughes Creek to the Goulburn Weir including Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the fireworks event, vessels operated by Strathbogie Shire Council and those vessels designated as berthed by Strathbogie Shire Council, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie as detailed in Table 1.

5.00 pm to 9.45 pm Friday 31 December 2010	Within 50 metres of the fireworks firing site located on a pontoon situated adjacent to the eastern end of the 'No Power Boat Zone' described in Item 14 of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the Marine Act 1988 .
9.45 pm to 10.15 pm Friday 31 December 2010	Within 150 metres of the fireworks firing site located on a pontoon situated adjacent to the eastern end of the 'No Power Boat Zone' described in Item 14 of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the Marine Act 1988 .

2. At the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Strathbogie Shire Council, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

I, Diane Julie Bates, Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Inspector Stephen Guilmartin, OIC – Water Police Squad/Search and Rescue Squad, Victoria Police, hereby give notice under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** that from 12.30 pm on Saturday 8 January 2011 until 6.00 pm on Saturday 8 January 2011, the operation of vessels, excluding Life Saving Victoria vessels associated with the 'Pier to Pub' swimming event, is prohibited on all waters inside an area bounded by the Lorne Pier, the Lorne foreshore and a line extending from the outer end of Lorne Pier to a position on the foreshore 200 metres north of the Lorne Surf Life Saving Club.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Vincent Wright, Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. From 9.15 pm till 9.45 pm Wednesday 26 January 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria and Parks Victoria staff, is prohibited within 55 metres radius seaward from a point on the shore approximately 150 metres west of the Altona Pier.
2. At the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 1 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
