I, Diane Julie Bates, Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Graeme Davis, Acting Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (the Waterway Manager for the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (a) between the hours of 8.15 pm Saturday 4 December 2010 and 10.30 pm Saturday 4 December 2010, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the fireworks event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria is prohibited within 200 metres of a fireworks barge located in the approximate position 38° 08.499'S, 144° 21.015'E, WGS84 (approximately 300 metres north west of the Royal Geelong Yacht Club)
- (b) at the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 1 contained in Notice No. 1 under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Graeme Davis, Acting Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip) hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Between the hours of 8.30 am and 5.00 pm Sunday 5 December 2010, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding those vessels involved with the DBV Docklands Cup Dragon Boat Festival is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River within the area detailed below in Table 1.

Table 1: Victoria Harbour Exclusion Zone

The waters bounded by:	
(i)	A line extending from a point 37°49' 4.517328" S, 144° 56' 32.55144" E to a point 37° 49' 1.674408" S, 144° 56' 39.984" E;
(ii)	A line extending from a point 37° 49' 1.674408" S, 144° 56' 39.984" E to a point 37° 49' 3.717228" S, 144° 56' 41.3412" E;
(iii)	A line extending from a point 37° 49' 3.717228" S, 144° 56' 41.3412" E to a point 37° 49' 6.613752" S, 144° 56' 33.76608" E;
(iv)	A line extending from a point 37° 49' 6.613752" S, 144° 56' 33.76608" E to a point 37°49' 4.517328" S, 144° 56' 32.55144" E.

2. Vessels providing rescue services are excluded from the requirements of Clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
3. At the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

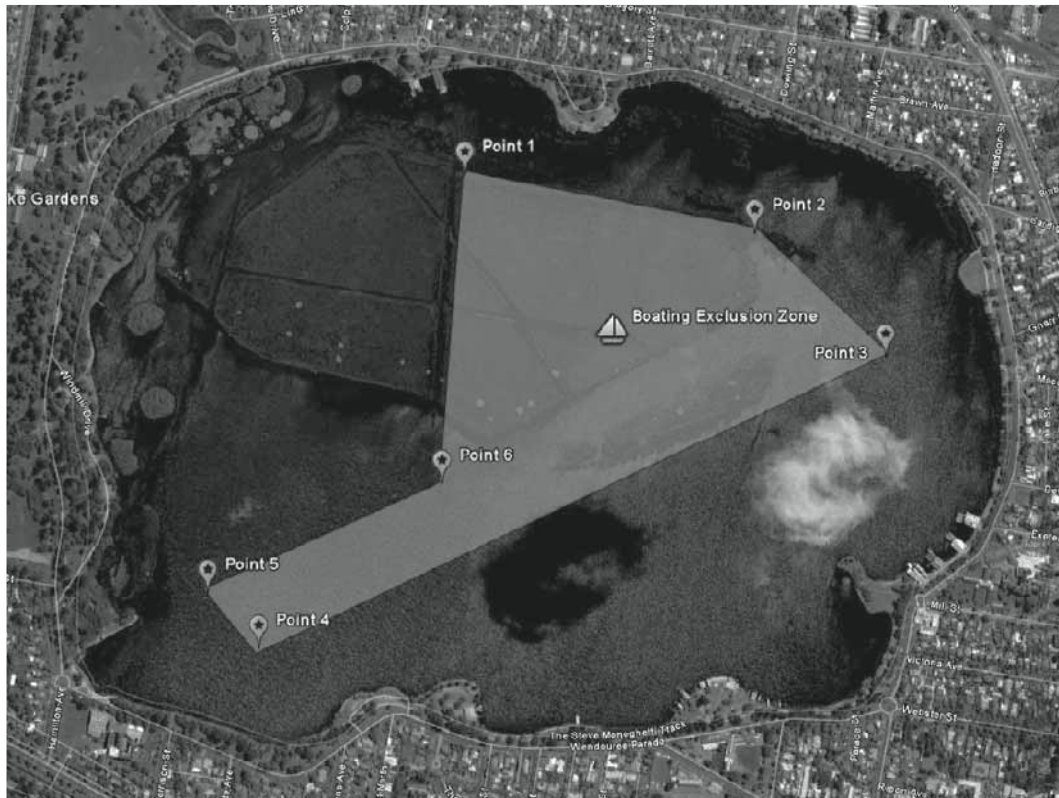
I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Bernard Blood, Curator Lake Wendouree, City of Ballarat (the Waterway Manager for Lake Wendouree), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Notice 466/2010 (as published in the Victoria Government Gazette S457, 5 November 2010), is hereby revoked; and

2. From 5.00 pm Friday 3 December 2010 till 5.00 pm Thursday 30 June 2011 the Waters of Lake Wendouree are subject to the following operating rules:
- A speed limit of 5 knots applies to all the waters of Lake Wendouree except areas prohibited to vessels.
 - Bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels authorised by the City of Ballarat, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Wendouree bounded by the Geo spatially referenced points detailed in Table 1.

Point 3	37°32'56.99"S	143°50'31.31"E
Point 4	37°33'17.64"S	143°49'37.65"E

- The operation of rowing vessels on Lake Wendouree is in an anti-clockwise direction around a line of yellow buoys at all times, except for rowing vessels engaged in official competition.

- (d) Powered vessels authorised by Ballarat City Council involved in rowing coaching and official rowing competition are excluded from the purposes of clause 2(a) (above) provided that powered vessels engaged in this activity display a red flag and do not exceed a speed greater than the rowing vessel being observed.
- (e) The whole of the waters of Lake Wendouree is prohibited to vessels when the water level falls below 600 mm of the overflow level of the Lake, as measured at the marker gauges located on the east side of the Lake approximately 120 metres south of Macarthur Street and on the south-west side at the end of the isthmus.
