Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Leah Johnston, Manager Infrastructure Services, Warrnambool City Council (the Waterway Manager for the Hopkins River between the Seaward Outlet and Tooram Stones) hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm on Sunday 21 February 2010 bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), is prohibited on the waters of the Hopkins River as detailed in Clause 1(1) of Schedule 22 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**, excluding:
 - (a) vessels associated with the Australian Whale Boat Racing Championships; and
 - (b) vessels transiting the Hopkins River from:
 - (i) the River Cruise Jetty; and
 - (ii) the boat ramp to the north of the Proudfoot Boathouse; and
 - (iii) the Warrnambool Water Ski Club,when travelling directly to the waters upstream of the 10 knot zone as detailed in Clause 1(1) of Schedule 22 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
2. competition vessels involved in the Australian Whale Boat Racing Championships are exempt from the provisions of section 231 of the Marine Regulations 2009.
3. at the completion of the events the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 22, contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Vincent Wright, Manager of Operations Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria, (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. between the hours of 9.00 am and 12.00 noon, 12.45 pm and 2.15 pm, and 3.00 pm and 4.00 pm on Saturday 20 February 2010, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria and vessels involved in the Australian Henley Regatta is prohibited on all the waters of the Yarra River between:
 - (a) an imaginary line extending from the downstream edge of the Victorian Rowing Association Landing to the Upstream edge of Federation Wharf; and
 - (b) the Church Street Bridge.
2. at the completion of the event the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Director Strategic and Community Development, Strathbogie Shire Council (the Waterway Manager for the Goulburn River between Hughes Creek and the Goulburn Weir including the waters of Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. for the dates and times listed in Table 1 the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie as described in item 14 of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** excluding:
 - (i) vessels owned and operated by Strathbogie Shire Council; and
 - (ii) vessels associated with the 2010 Open and Age Water Swimming Championships.

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Darren Schultz, Building and Contracts Officer, Loddon Shire Council, the Waterway Manager for The Loddon River (at Bridgewater between the Flour Mill Weir and Sweenys Lane), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (a) from 8.00 am Saturday 27 February 2010 till 7.30. pm Sunday 28 February 2010, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Pre Moomba Water Skiing Tournament, is prohibited on all the waters of the Loddon River at Bridgewater, between the Calder Highway Bridge and Sweenys Lane;
- (b) vessels involved in the Pre Moomba Water Skiing Tournament are excluded from the requirements of clauses 2(1), 2(2)(a), and 5 as contained in Schedule 62 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
- (c) vessels involved in the Pre Moomba Water Skiing Tournament are excluded from the requirements of clauses 3(a), 3(b) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
- (d) at the completion of the event the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 62 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Chris Hardman, Operations Manager, Bays and Marine, Parks Victoria, (Waterway Manager for the Designated Port of Western Port), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. from 10.00 am till 3.00 pm Sunday 28 February 2010 the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels operated by Parks Victoria and the Victorian Outboard Club associated with the Victorian Outboard Club demonstration is prohibited on the waters of Hastings Bight, Western Port, in an area extending north from a line commencing at a point on the shore approximately 80 metres north of the Hastings Jetty located at 38° 18.43' S and 145° 11.87' E to a point on the shore approximately 100 metres west of the BHP slipway located at 38° 18.25' S and 145° 12.44' E.
(Projection: WGS 84).
2. vessels involved in the Victorian Outboard Club Demonstration are exempt from requirements of Clause 7 as related to point 3(d) of Schedule 5 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
3. vessels involved in the Victorian Outboard Club Demonstration are exempt from requirements of Clause 2(c) 4(a) and 4(b) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
4. at the completion of the event the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 5 contained in Notice No. 1 under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
