Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Wayne Hill, Acting Manager Operations, Bays and Marine, Parks Victoria (the Waterway Manager for the Designated Port of Western Port), hereby:

1. give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that due to time changes the exclusion zone for the Cowes Classic Swim detailed in Notice 422/2010, 1(b) (published in the Victorian Government Gazette S24, 20 January 2010), is hereby revoked; and
2. give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that for the times, dates and locations listed below, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels operated by Parks Victoria and Life Saving Victoria associated with the Cowes Classic swim event, is prohibited on the following waters of the Designated Port of Western Port:
 - (a) Cowes Classic swimming event between the hours of 2.00 pm and 2.30 pm Saturday 13 February 2010.

The waters within 300 metres of the waters edge which lie to seaward between two lines extending seaward at right angles to the shore;

 - (i) one line extending from Mussel Rock (approximately 300 metres West of Cowes Jetty), and
 - (ii) one line extending from the land beacon with a red triangular topmark on Erehwon Point, Phillip Island.
 - (iii) Vessels involved in the Phillip Island Swim Classic swimming event are excluded from the requirements of Clause 2(a), 2(c) and 4b of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
 - (iv) Life Saving Victoria vessels and operators are excluded from the requirements of Sections 228 and 231 of the Marine Regulations 2009.
3. at the completion of the events the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 5, contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Vincent Wright, Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (a) between the hours of 7.00 am and 6.00 pm Sunday 7 January 2010, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding those vessels involved with the Chinese New Year Dragon Boat Festival, is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River within the area detailed below in Table 1:

Table 1: Victoria Harbour Exclusion Zone

The waters bounded by:	
(i)	a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 4.94" S, 144° 56' 31.93" E to a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 3.49" S, 144° 56' 43.15" E;
(ii)	a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 3.49" S, 144° 56' 43.15" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 1.63" S, 144° 56' 42.29" E;
(iii)	a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 1.63" S, 144° 56' 42.29" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 7.26" S, 144° 56' 33.16" E; and
(iv)	a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 7.26" S, 144° 56' 33.16" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 4.94" S, 144° 56' 31.93" E.

- (b) vessels providing rescue services are excluded from the requirements of Clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**; and
- (c) at the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
