### ROAD SAFETY (VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 2009

#### Class 3 Notice for Log Trucks

**1. Purpose**

The purpose of this notice is to declare certain log trucks to be class 3 vehicles and to exempt them from a dimension limit in the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009 (in this notice referred to as the Vehicles Regulations).

**2. Authorising provision**

This notice is made under regulation 193(2) and regulation 194 of the Vehicles Regulations. Regulation 193(2) provides that the Roads Corporation, by notice in the Government Gazette, may declare a category of vehicles to be class 3 vehicles.

Regulation 194 provides that the Roads Corporation may, by notice published in the Government Gazette, exempt a category of class 3 vehicles from a mass or dimension limit set out in Schedule 9 to the Regulations.

Clause 10 of Schedule 9 requires a vehicle that combines with another vehicle to form a 4 axle dog trailer combination to comply with the relevant dimension limits in Part 4.2 of Chapter 4 to the Vehicles Regulations.

**3. Commencement**

This notice comes into operation on the date it is published in the Government Gazette.

**4. Revocation**

The notice published in Government Gazette No. S 277 on 22 December 2004 entitled Class 3 Notice for Log Trucks is revoked.

**5. Expiry**

This Notice expires on 9 November 2014.

**6. Declaration**

I, George Mavroyeni, delegate of the Roads Corporation, declare that a combination consisting of a 3 axle truck connected to a 4 axle dog trailer is a class 3 vehicle while it is being used to transport logs.

**7. Exemption**

I, George Mavroyeni, delegate of the Roads Corporation, exempt a combination consisting of a 3 axle truck connected to a 4 axle dog trailer, transporting logs, from the length limit of 19 metres in regulation 168 of the Vehicles Regulations (with which the combination would otherwise be required to comply under clause 10 of Schedule 9) on the conditions that:

- (a) the combination does not exceed 22.0 metres in length; and
- (b) the registered operator of the truck ensures that the combination can be safely operated.

Note: Words and phrases in this notice have the same meanings as in the **Road Safety Act 1986** and the Regulations under that Act.
