SCHEDULE TO THE ORDER IN COUNCIL

1. Appointment Arrangements

The appointments are on a sessional basis.

2. Period of Appointment

1 May 2010 to 30 April 2015 (both dates inclusive).

3. Duties and responsibilities of the position

The function of the Disciplinary Appeals Board is to hear and determine appeals by an employee in the Victorian Government School Teaching Service in relation to a decision of the Secretary in relation to misconduct under Part 10 or unsatisfactory performance under Part 9A of Chapter 2.4 of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006**. The appointees meet the legislative requirements in the legislation and are either persons admitted to legal practice in Victoria for not less than five years, employees in the teaching service or persons with knowledge or experience in education, education administration or public sector administration.

SPECIAL

4. Termination Arrangements

Section 2.4.75(1) of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006** states that a member may resign from office by sending to the Governor a signed letter of resignation. Section 2.4.75(2) states that the Governor in Council may at any time remove a member from office.

5. Payment Provisions

Under the Appointment and Remuneration Guidelines for Victorian Government Boards, Statutory Bodies and Advisory Committees a Disciplinary Appeals Board is classified as a Group B, Band 1 Organisation. The fee per day for legally qualified Chairpersons is from \$328 to \$519 and the fee per day for other members is \$251 to \$449. Chairpersons and other members will be remunerated at the top of the range.

Section 2.4.74(2) of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006** states that a member of a Disciplinary Appeals Board, other than a public servant or an employee [being a member of the teaching service] is entitled to the remuneration and allowances (if any) fixed in respect of the member from time to time by the Minister.

Entitled to reimbursement of reasonable travelling and personal expenses.
