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## Marine Act 1988

### SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Marine Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Bernie Dunn, Natural Resource Planner, Grampians Wimmera Mallee Water (the Waterway Manager for Taylors Lake) hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. the rules regulating the operation of vessels on the waters of Taylors Lake set out in Schedule 143 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** are hereby revoked; and
2. replaced by the following rules regulating the operation of vessels on the waters of Taylors Lake.

### SCHEDULE 143

#### WATERS-TAYLORS LAKE (HORSHAM)

Waterway Manager – Wimmera Mallee Rural Water Authority

1. Excluded speed limit for the purposes of Clause 3(a).  
Those waters of Taylors Lake which are not otherwise specified as a 5 knot speed restriction zone, an area prohibited to vessels, or exclusive use and special purpose area are excluded from the provisions of Clause 3(a) of this notice.
2. 5 knot speed restriction zones for the purpose of Clause 7.  
The waters of Taylors Lake shoreward of a line of buoys (in the approximate positions <sup>1-14</sup>) are subject to a speed restriction of 5 knots.
3. Areas prohibited to vessels for the purposes of Clause 9.  
The following waters of Taylors Lake are prohibited to vessels.
  - (a) The waters of Taylors Lake bounded by a 'Vessels Prohibited' sign <sup>15</sup> on the shore 40 metres NE of Outlet Channel and a 'Vessels Prohibited' sign <sup>16</sup> on the shore 30 metres SW of Outlet Channel, and two red buoys <sup>3,4</sup>.
  - (b) The waters of Taylors Lake south of an imaginary line between two points on opposite banks of the Inlet Channel <sup>17,18</sup>.
4. Areas prohibited to bathers for the purposes of Clause 12.  
The waters of Taylors Lake 30 metres either side of the boat ramp on the north-eastern shore as indicated by 'No Swimming' signs on the shore <sup>19,20</sup> and extending 50 metres from the waters edge are prohibited to bathers.
5. Exclusive Use and Special Purpose Areas for the purposes of Clause 13.  
The waters of Taylors Lake 30 metres either side of the boat ramp on the north-eastern shore as indicated by 'Launching and Retrieval Only' signs <sup>19,20</sup> on the shore and extending 50 metres from the waters edge are set aside for vessels engaged in launching and retrieval.
