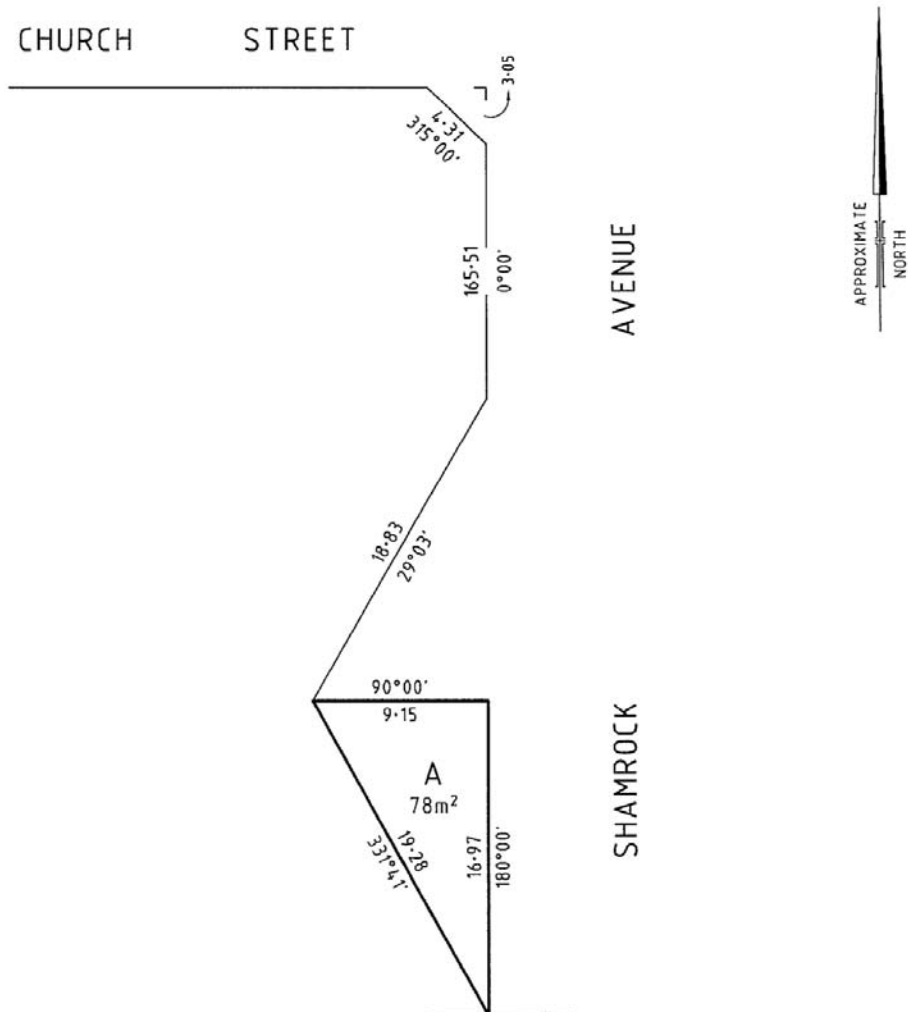

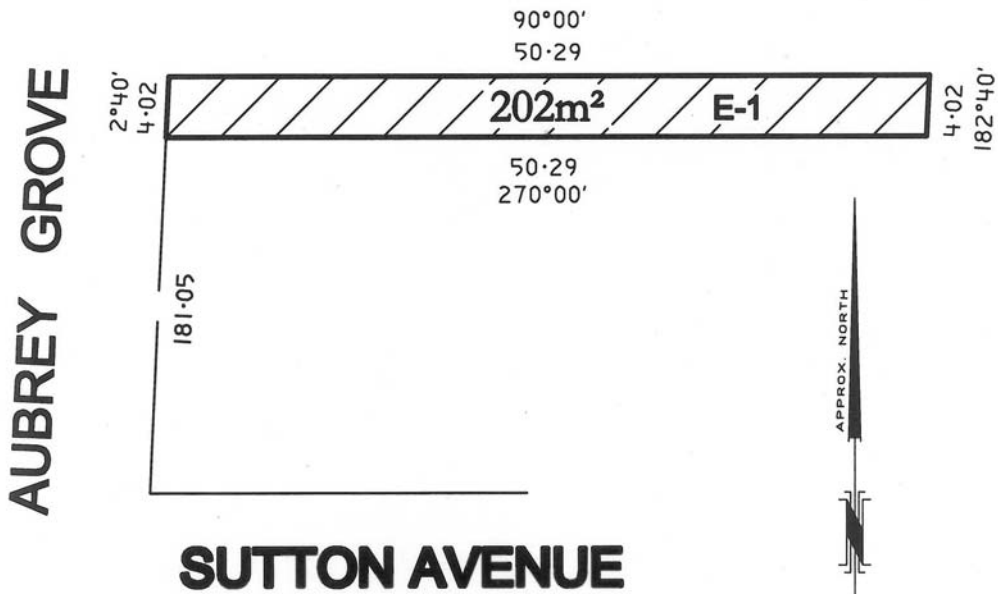

Council has resolved to discontinue this section of road reserve and to sell the land by private treaty to the abutting property owner.

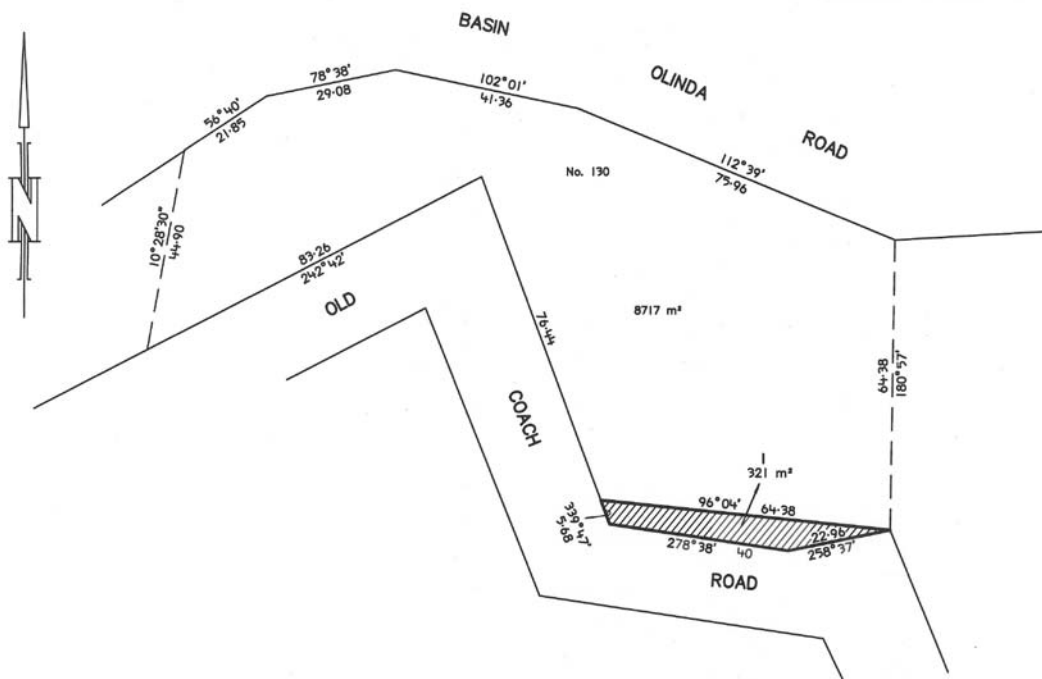

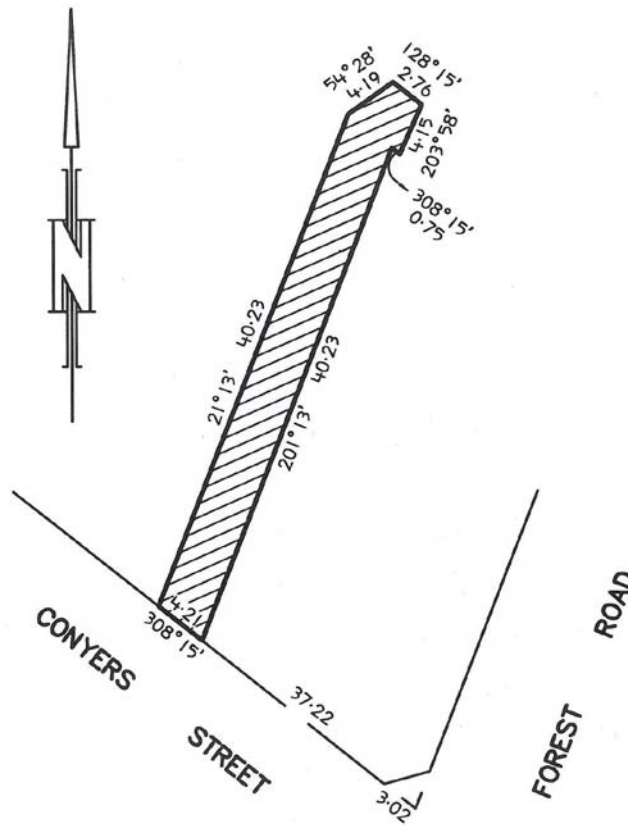

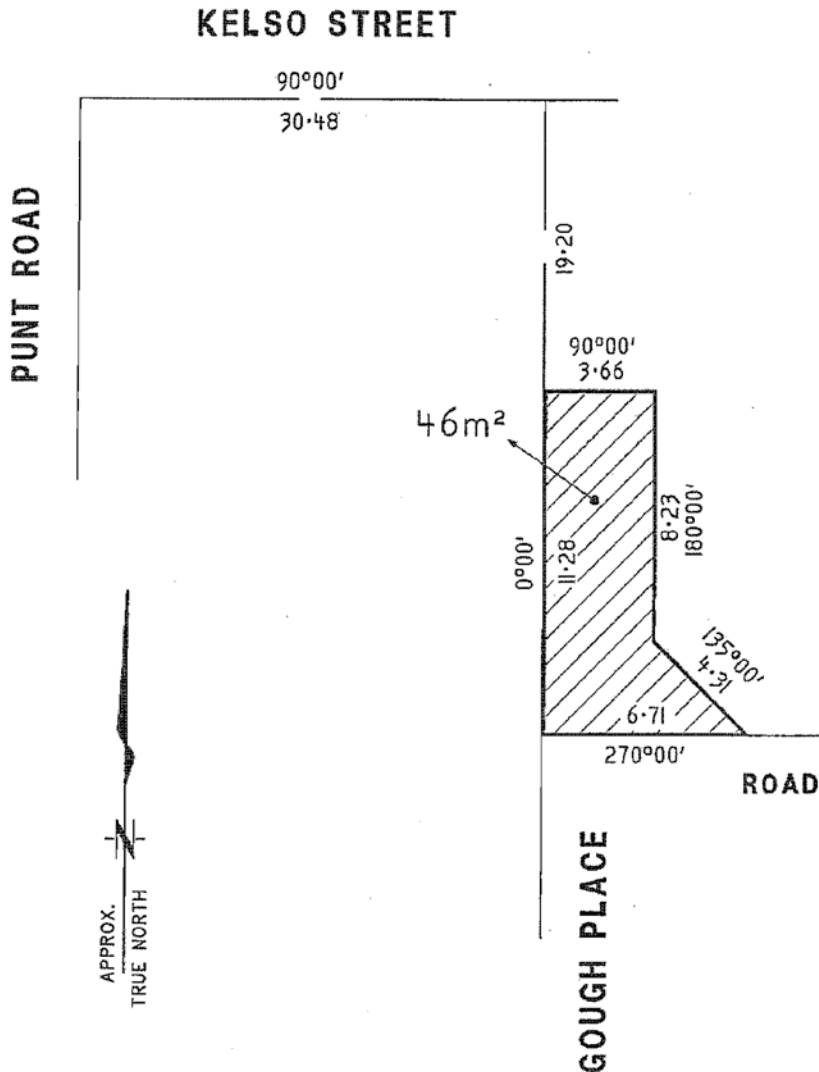

Road Management Act 2004

Review of Road Management Plan

In accordance with section 54(5) of the **Road Management Act 2004** (the Act), Yarriambiack Shire Council gives notice it has conducted a review of its Road Management Plan (the Plan).

The purpose of the review, consistent with the role, functions and responsibilities of the Council as a road authority under the Act, is to ensure the standards in relation to and the priorities to be given to the inspection, maintenance and repair of the roads and the classes of road to which the Council's Road Management Plan applies are safe, efficient and appropriate for use by the community served by the Council.

The following 2009 Plan sections have been amended:

Section 5.2.2 Maintenance Resealing of Sealed Roads

Condition inspections—auditors recommendation is Council inspect 20% of its road network per year.

5.9.1 Asset Condition Surveys

Asset condition surveys – auditors recommendation is Council inspect 20% of the following categories: Sealed Roads; Gravel Roads; Footpaths; Kerb and Channel; Street Furniture; Bridges and Culverts.

5.9.4 Regular Maintenance Inspections – Bridge and Major Culverts

Level 2 inspections have been changed to every three years from two, as recommended by independent bridge and culvert inspection consultant and meets new regulations that have been implemented.

The Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (the Tribunal) has considered an application, pursuant to section 83 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 1995** (the Act), by Mind Australia (the applicant). The application for exemption is to enable the applicant to advertise

for and employ a full time male team leader to work at Trelowarren House, a residential recovery program for adults experiencing mental health issues (the exempt conduct).

Upon reading the material submitted in support of the application, including the affidavit of Heidi Gratton, the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- The applicant's staff work to support clients to develop a better understanding of their mental health, develop living skills, improve social relationships and make meaningful links with the community.
- The client base at Trelowarren House is currently 10 males to five females and this has been the ratio for the last three years. The applicant seeks to ensure that the gender ratio of staff reflects the gender ratio of the client base. A male previously held the vacant position and the absence of a full-time male in this position leaves a gap in the applicant's capacity to work with the male clients.
- Support workers are required to work closely with male clients in relation to exploring sensitive issues relating to men's health, exploring self identity and sexual orientation. These issues are at times more suited to male/male working relationships. Many clients have experienced negative and at times traumatic personal relationships. These negative experiences can hinder an individual's ability to engage appropriately with a worker of the opposite gender. To be sensitive to the male client's needs, the opportunity to provide a male staff member for a predominantly male client group is essential.
- The Tribunal has previously granted the applicant exemptions for the purpose of ensuring that the gender base of the applicant's clients can be supported by staff of the same gender (A4/2009 and A277/2009).

The Tribunal hereby grants an exemption to the applicant from the operation of sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

This exemption is to remain in force from the day on which notice of the exemption is published in the Government Gazette until 25 August 2013.

APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER TO THE VICTORIA GRANTS COMMISSION

SCHEDULE TO THE ORDER IN COUNCIL

1. Appointment Arrangements

The appointment is on a part-time basis.

2. Duties and responsibilities of the position

Under the **Victoria Grants Commission Act 1976** (the Act), the primary function of the Victoria Grants Commission (the Commission) is to allocate general revenue assistance provided by the Commonwealth Government to municipal councils in Victoria in accordance with the **Local Government (Financial Assistance) Act 1995** and the approved national distribution principles.

The responsibilities of the position include:

- Make recommendations as to the allocation of general revenue assistance to the 79 local governments, which are forwarded to the Commonwealth Government by the Victorian Minister for Local Government.
- Actively participate in the determination and administration of a formula for the allocation of Commonwealth funds to municipalities that is in accordance with the six approved national distribution principles.
- Actively participate in a regular programme of communication and liaison with the local government sector to ensure that the sector is fully informed as to the Commission's role and methodology and that the Commission is aware of relevant issues affecting councils and the broader community.
- Participate in meetings with individual councils to ensure that the councils have the ability to understand how their grant outcomes are determined.
- Provide Councils with an opportunity to make written submissions in relation to their allocation and review these submissions as appropriate.
- Attend meetings of the Commission and contribute to discussions on funding methodology. Regularly review grant allocation formula to ensure its relevance to local government and the State's circumstances.
- Liaise with stakeholders to measure success of the funding formula.

3. Termination Arrangements

Section 7 of the Act provides for the suspension and removal from office of members of the Commission.

Section 8 of the Act provides for the vacation of office of members. A member shall be deemed to have vacated that office if –

- (a) the member becomes bankrupt or the member's property becomes subject to control under the law relating to bankruptcy, or the member compounds with the member's creditors or makes an assignment of the whole or any part of any remuneration to which the member is or may be entitled pursuant to this Act for their benefit;
- (b) except with the leave of the Minister, the member absents himself from duty for fourteen consecutive days or for twenty-eight days in any twelve months;
- (c) the member becomes permanently incapable of performing that member's duties; or
- (d) the member resigns by writing under that member's hand, addressed to the Governor in Council.

4. Payment Provisions

Under section 6(1) of the Act, the chairperson and each of the other members of the Commission shall each receive such remuneration and travelling and other allowances as are determined by the Governor in Council. The current remuneration for eligible Commission members is a sitting fee of \$380 per full day sitting or \$190 per half day sitting.

5. Superannuation Obligations

Superannuation will be paid out in accordance with the Commonwealth **Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992**.

6. Travel and Personal Expenses arrangements

Section 6(1) of the Act provides that reasonable expenses incurred in conducting the work of the Commission will be reimbursed.

7. Leave Arrangements

Not applicable.
