ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ORDER (NO. 205) 2010

- 1. Title**

This Order is called the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 205) 2010.
- 2. Authorising provisions**

This Order is made under sections 3 and 5 of the **Administrative Arrangements Act 1983**.
- 3. Operation and effect of Order**

This Order takes effect on 1 October 2010.
- 4. Definitions**

In this Order –

 - ‘**Body**’ means Minister, Department or officer;
 - ‘**instrument**’ includes contract and agreement;
 - ‘**Old Body**’ means a Body specified in Column 1 in the Schedule;
 - ‘**New Body**’ means a Body specified in Column 3 in the Schedule;
 - ‘**Schedule**’ means Schedule to this Order;
 - ‘**transaction**’ includes –
 - (a) agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement; and
 - (b) action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution or other legal proceeding; and
 - (c) assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property; and
 - (d) loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money; and
 - (e) approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, order, permit, requirement or other authority; and
 - (f) notice; and
 - (g) any other act, entitlement or liability at law.
- 5. Construction of references**

In respect of each item in the Schedule, a reference to the Old Body specified in Column 1 of an item, in an instrument specified in Column 2 of an item, is deemed to be a reference to the New Body specified in Column 3 of that item.
- 6. Saving of existing transactions**

If a transaction happened in relation to an Old Body before this Order takes effect –
 - (a) this Order does not affect the validity or continuity of the transaction; and
 - (b) the transaction shall continue and may be completed in relation to the New Body in the same way as it would have been continued and may have been completed in relation to the Old Body if this Order had not been made; and

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- (c) the transaction may be given effect to, or enforced or completed, by the New Body in the same way as it would have been given effect to, or enforced or completed, by the Old Body as if this Order had not been made.

7. Keeping financial accounts and reports

The Secretary, Department of Justice must ensure that financial accounts are kept and reports are provided for the purposes of the **Financial Management Act 1994** until 30 September 2010 in respect of functions under the instruments specified in Schedule 1 that are transferred to CenITex as if the functions had not been transferred.

8. Providing financial accounts and reports

CenITex must, if requested by the Secretary, Department of Justice, provide the Secretary, Department of Justice with any financial accounts and records or other information required to enable the Secretary, Department of Justice to comply with clause 7.
