DECLARATION OF CORRESPONDING CATEGORIES OF WRITTEN-OFF VEHICLES

Order in Council

The Governor in Council under section 16B(2) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** by this Order declares that the category of written-off vehicle on a written-off vehicles register of –

- (a) the State of New South Wales that is specified as –
 - (i) a statutory write-off corresponds to a statutory write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
 - (ii) a repairable write-off corresponds to a repairable write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
- (b) the State of Queensland that is specified as –
 - (i) a statutory write-off corresponds to a statutory write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
 - (ii) a repairable write-off corresponds to a repairable write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
- (c) the State of South Australia that is specified as –
 - (i) a statutory write-off corresponds to a statutory write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
 - (ii) a repairable write-off corresponds to a repairable write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
- (d) the State of Western Australia that is specified as –
 - (i) a statutory write-off corresponds to a statutory write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
 - (ii) a repairable write-off corresponds to a repairable write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
- (e) the State of Tasmania that is specified as –
 - (i) a statutory write-off corresponds to a statutory write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
 - (ii) a repairable write-off corresponds to a repairable write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
- (f) the Northern Territory that is specified as –
 - (i) a statutory write-off corresponds to a statutory write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
 - (ii) a repairable write-off corresponds to a repairable write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and

SPECIAL

- (g) the Australian Capital Territory that is specified as –
- (i) a statutory write-off corresponds to a statutory write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**; and
 - (ii) a repairable write-off corresponds to a repairable write-off under Division 3 of Part 2 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**.

This Order is effective from the date it is published in the Government Gazette.
