SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Warren Chapman, Reserve Manager, Barwon Coast Committee of Management hereby give notice under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Notice 479/2010 (as published in the Victorian Government Gazette S489, 10 December 2010), is hereby revoked, and that
2. from 9.00 am Monday 17 January 2011 till 5.00 pm Friday 27 May 2011,
 - (a) bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring, drifting or allowing a vessel to lie), is prohibited on the waters of the Barwon River as detailed in Table 1, (and indicated by yellow buoys in the water) except for those waters designated as a Transit Lane and delineated by red and green buoys,
 - (b) the operator, master or person in charge of a vessel must not use the Transit Lane other than for transiting of the vessel and must not permit the vessel to be anchored, drift or moored in the Transit Lane,
 - (c) bathing is prohibited in the Transit Lane.

The waters bounded by:

- (i) A line extending from a point on the shore located in the position 38° 16' 57.11" S, 144° 29' 41.99" E to a point on the shore located in the position 38° 16' 56.44" S, 144° 29' 50.31" E;
- (ii) A line extending from a point on the shore located in the position 38° 16' 56.44" S, 144° 29' 50.31" E to a point on the shore located in the position 38° 16' 58.12" S, 144° 29' 49.53" E;
- (iii) A line extending from a point on the shore located in the position 38° 16' 58.12" S, 144° 29' 49.53" E to a point on the shore located in the position 38° 16' 58.74" S, 144° 29' 41.91" E;
- (iv) A line extending from a point on the shore located in the position 38° 16' 58.74" S, 144° 29' 41.91" E; to a point on the shore located in the position 38° 16' 57.11" S, 144° 29' 41.99" E.

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Geoff Barrow, Ranger in Charge Wangaratta, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for Lake Moodemere), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. from 6.00 am Friday 14 January to 6.00 pm Sunday 16 January 2010, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Murray River Rowing Association Annual Regatta, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Moodemere;
2. from 6.00 am Friday 14 January to 6.00 pm Sunday 16 January 2010, vessels involved in the Murray Rowing Association Annual Regatta are excluded from the requirements of Clause 2(c) and Clause 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**; and

1. from 8.00 pm to 11.30 pm Saturday 22 January 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Audi Victoria Week Fireworks Event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited within 120 metres of fireworks barges located on Corio Bay approximately 200 metres north of the Royal Geelong Yacht Club breakwater; and
2. at the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 1 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Vincent Wright, Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Local Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. from 8.30 pm til 10.30 pm Wednesday 26 January 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the fireworks event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited within a 250 metre radius of a fireworks barge located approximately 250 metres east of the Mornington Pier Head;
2. from 8.30 pm til 10.30 pm Wednesday 26 January 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the fireworks event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria is prohibited within a 200 metre radius of a fireworks barge located approximately 200 metres from the east side of the Rye Pier and 240 metres seaward from the Rye foreshore; and
3. at the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 1 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
