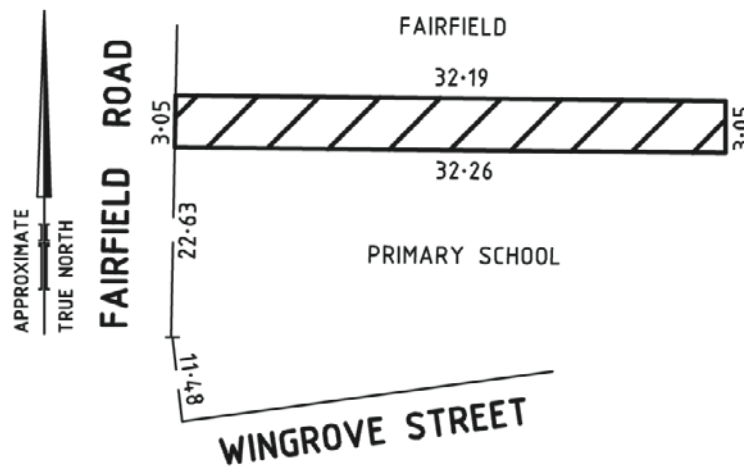

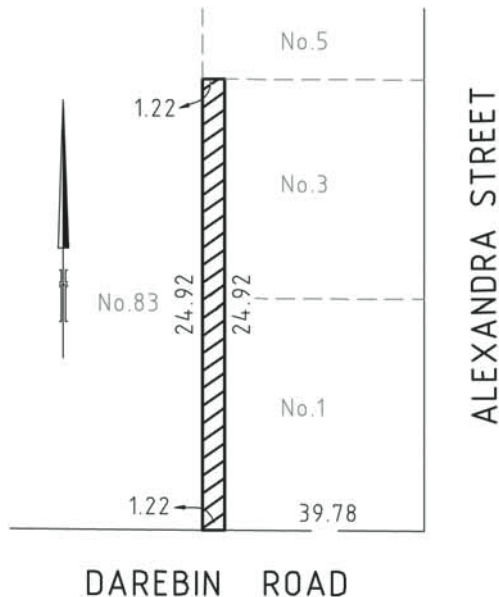

EXEMPTION

Application No. A352/2010

The Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (the Tribunal) has considered an application, pursuant to section 83 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 1995** (the Act), by National Heart Foundation of Australia (the applicant). The application for exemption is to enable the applicant to advertise for and employ an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person in the role of Administrative Assistant in the applicant's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Unit (the exempt conduct).

Upon reading the material submitted in support of the application, including the affidavit of Heather McQuiggin, the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- The applicant has a specific strategy to look at the needs of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in respect of improving access to programmes for the prevention and treatment of cardiovascular disease. That strategy is implemented by the applicant's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Unit.

- The position of administrative assistant in that Unit is offered as a traineeship with the prospect of future career progression within the applicant. The holder of the role will be required to provide central administration support and coordination for the Unit. A requirement for the position holder is for he or she to have a good knowledge of Aboriginal health and communities and a capacity to communicate work with other members of the Unit. The applicant believes it would be appropriate for the holder of the position to be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent.
- When making decisions about exemptions, the Tribunal is required to give proper consideration to relevant human rights as set out in the **Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities Act 2006** (Charter). Arguably, this exemption limits the right to equal and effective protection against discrimination of a non-Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person wishing to apply for the Administrative Assistant role. I am satisfied that the exemption is a measure taken for the purpose of assisting or advancing Aboriginal people who are disadvantaged and so it does not amount to discrimination under the Charter. In any event, in the circumstances discussed above, the limit imposed by this exemption is reasonable and justified under the Charter.

The Tribunal hereby grants an exemption to the applicant from the operation of sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

This exemption is to remain in force from the day on which notice of the exemption is published in the Government Gazette until 5 January 2014.

EXEMPTION

Application No. A357/2010

The Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (the Tribunal) has considered an application, pursuant to section 83 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 1995** (the Act), by Western Region Centre Against Sexual Assault (the

applicant). The application for exemption is to enable the applicant to advertise for and employ only a woman in the position of Senior Counsellor Advocate (the exempt conduct).

Upon reading the material submitted in support of the application, including the affidavit of Jane Vanderstoel, the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- The applicant is one of 15 centres funded by the Victorian Government, Department of Human Services. Its primary role is to provide counselling, advocacy and other support services to victims/survivors of sexual assault and their non-offending family members and friends.
- The Senior Counselling Advocate leads the counselling team and must be available to supervise and, where required, provide all aspects of services including undertaking tasks such as managing the provision of crisis care and on-going counselling to victims.
- Over 90% of the perpetrators of sexual violence are male. The applicant has a male counsellor on staff but it has found that, when asked, approximately 80% of its clients, male and female, express a preference for a female to provide counselling. As the Senior Counsellor Advocate's role includes providing counselling on a duty basis and when another counsellor is unavailable, it is preferable for the holder of the role to be female to ensure that appropriate support can be given to all clients.
- When making decisions about exemptions, the Tribunal is required to give proper consideration to relevant human rights as set out in the **Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities Act 2006** (Charter). Arguably, this exemption limits the right to equal and effective protection against discrimination of a male wishing to apply for the Senior Counsellor Advocate. I am satisfied that, in the circumstances discussed above, the limit imposed by this exemption is reasonable and justified under the Charter.

The Tribunal hereby grants an exemption to the applicant from the operation of sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

This exemption is to remain in force from the day on which notice of the exemption is published in the Government Gazette until 5 January 2014.

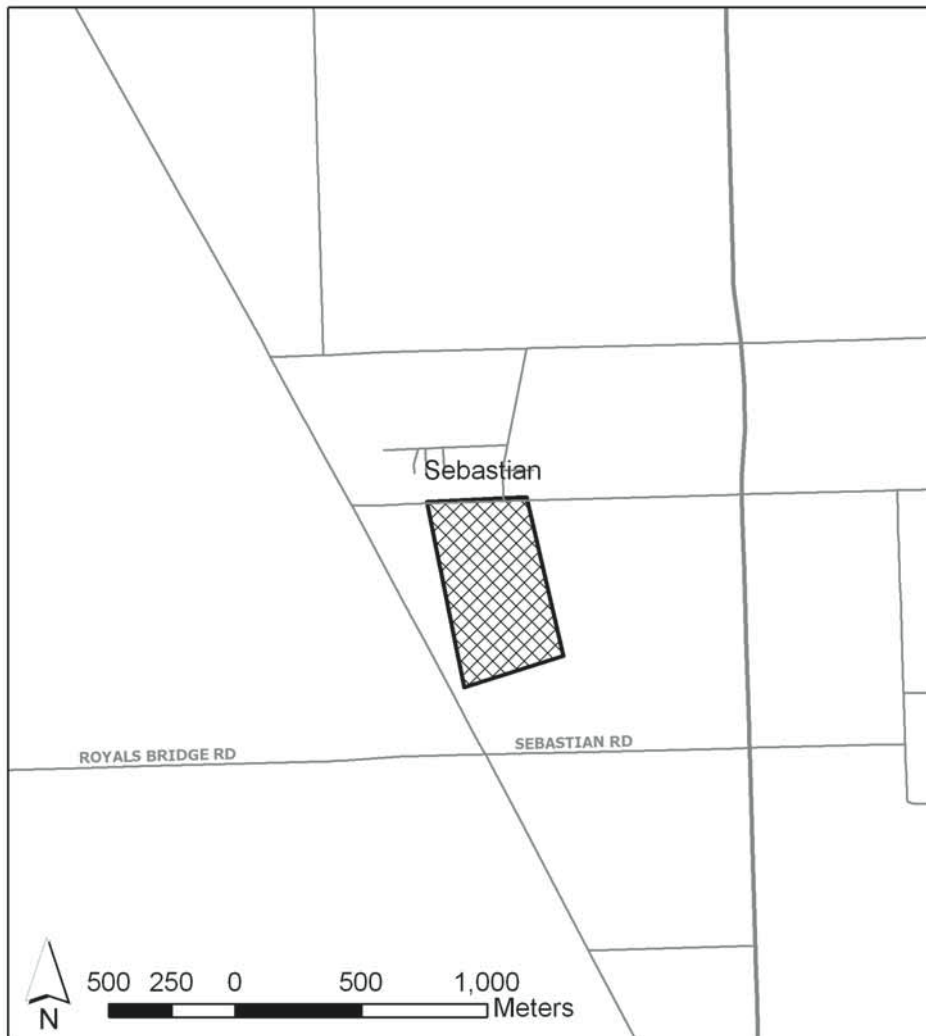
