SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Vincent Wright, Manager of Operations Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. from 8.45 pm on Saturday 22 October 2011 until 9.45 pm on Saturday 22 October 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) excepting Parks Victoria vessels and those vessels involved in the presentation of the Diwali Festival Fireworks Display, is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River between
 - (a) the downstream edge of Princes Bridge, and
 - (b) the upstream edge of Federation Wharf.
2. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Parks Victoria to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Neil Lawson, Public Affairs Manager, International Power-GDF SUEZ Hazelwood (the Waterway Manager for Hazelwood Cooling Pond), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. From 8.00 am to 3.00 pm on Saturday 15 and Sunday 16 October 2011, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Victorian Open Water Swim event, is prohibited on the waters of Hazelwood Cooling Pond.
2. Rescue vessels involved in the Victorian Open Water Swim event are excluded from Clause 1(d) contained in Schedule 110 of Notice No. 1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
3. Rescue vessels involved with the Victorian Open Water Swim event are excluded from Clauses 2(a) and 3(a) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.

SPECIAL

4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by International Power–GDF SUEZ Hazelwood to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 110 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Chief Executive Officer, Shire of Strathbogie (the Waterway Manager for the Goulburn River between Hughes Creek and the Goulburn Weir including the waters of Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that –

1. From 8.30 am to 1.00 pm on Saturday 22 October 2011, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Head of the Goulburn rowing event and vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie, is prohibited on the following waters of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** –
 - (a) Goulburn River from the upstream boundary of the 5 knot speed restriction zone adjacent to Tahbilk Winery described in Item 4(a)(iii), to the upstream boundary of the 5 knot zone adjacent to the Nagambie Lakes Leisure Park described in Item 4(a)(iv); and
 - (b) Lake Nagambie within Furlong Cove, west of a 'Waters Closed' buoy (adjacent to the rowing compound).
2. Vessels involved in the Head of the Goulburn rowing event are exempt from the 5 knot speed limit adjacent to the Tahbilk Winery as described in Item 4(a)(iii) of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
3. Vessels authorised by the Shire of Strathbogie as rescue vessels for the Head of the Goulburn rowing event are excluded from the requirements of clauses 2(a) and 2(c) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by the Shire of Strathbogie to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No.1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Geoffrey Rollinson, Director, Infrastructure Planning and Regulatory Services, Gannawarra Shire Council (Waterway Manager for Lake Charm), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Between the hours of 6.30 am and 7.00 pm on Saturday 15 October 2011 and between 6.30 am and 7.00 pm Sunday 16 October 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels and bathers associated with the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 2, is prohibited on all of the waters of Lake Charm;
2. Vessels associated with the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 2 at Lake Charm are excluded from the provisions of Schedule 139 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event;
3. Vessels competing in the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 2 at Lake Charm are excluded from the requirements of Clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 3(b) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event;
4. Vessels competing in the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 2 at Lake Charm are exempt from the requirements of Regulation 228(3) of the Marine Regulations 2009, in respect to the requirement to carry a torch, bailer, and bucket for the duration of the event; and
5. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Gannawarra Shire Council to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 139 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
