## Gambling Regulation Act 2003

### APPROVAL OF KENO GAMES FOR BETTING PURPOSES

#### Keno Bonus

I, Hon. Michael O'Brien MP, Minister for Gaming, under section 6A.2A.1 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** (the Act), approve Keno Bonus as a keno game authorised to be conducted by the keno licensee subject to the Act and any conditions to which the licence is subject.

The details of the approved game are as specified:

1. Name of the game: Keno Bonus
2. Summary of the key aspects of the game:
  - (i) In each draw, the 20 numbers drawn from 80 numbers in the Keno Classic game, by a random number generator (RNG), determine the result of the Keno Bonus game.
  - (ii) Winning entries are determined by the combined total of the 20 numbers drawn in the Keno Classic game. This corresponds to a number in one of a number of 'multiplier' categories that randomly 'multiplies' all 'non Jackpot' prizes and fixed odds components of Jackpot Prizes) won in the Keno Classic game (the 'multiplier' applies to award separate additional prize components in relation to Jackpot Prizes).  
A customer must purchase a Keno Classic entry to participate in Keno Bonus.
  - (iii) A Multiplier of regular win, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 10 times may be applicable, and with the exception of a regular win, multiplies all 'non Jackpot' prizes won in the Keno Classic game and in the case of Jackpot prizes, an additional prize is awarded.  
The Multipliers are designed to produce an average return to player which is consistent with legislative requirements. Extra Promotional Prizes may be offered from time to time.
  - (iv) Draws are conducted every two minutes and thirty seconds to four minutes, seven days a week, with a ten minute break daily at 4am to undertake end of day IT requirements.
3. Entries into the next scheduled Keno Classic draw and associated Keno Bonus game can be purchased by a player up to 'draw close', which is up to 5 seconds before that draw is scheduled to be conducted. Once entry into the next scheduled Keno Classic draw has closed, players may immediately purchase an entry in the draw after the next scheduled draw.
4. Distribution Approach/Points of Sale:
  - Venues that have a pub licence;
  - Venues that have a full or restricted club licence;
  - Venues that are Wagering outlets; and
  - Any other distribution approaches/points of sale permitted under the keno licence from time to time.

This approval takes effect on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.
