SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Chief Executive Officer, Shire of Strathbogie (the Waterway Manager for the Goulburn River between Hughes Creek and the Goulburn Weir including the waters of Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- For the periods listed in Table A, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) is prohibited on the waters of the Goulburn River between the upstream boundary of the 5 knot speed restriction zone adjacent to Tahbilk Winery and Sandy Creek, excluding –
 - vessels involved with the events listed Table A of this Notice, and
 - vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie, and
 - vessels transiting the area under supervision.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of David Jackson, Manager Land & On Water, Goulburn Murray Water (Waterway Manager for Lake Eppalock), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Saturday 26 October 2011, and 6.00 am and 6.00 pm on Sunday 27 November 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Victorian Speed Boat Club Australian Championships and vessels operated by Goulburn Murray Water, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Eppalock in an area marked by buoys in the Derrinal Pool area in the vicinity of the VSBC leasehold;
2. Vessels engaged in the Victorian Speed Boat Club Australian Championships competition and vessels operated by Goulburn Murray Water are excluded from:
 - (a) the requirements of Schedule 49 of Notice No.1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** when operating within the exclusion zone detailed above; and
 - (b) the requirements of Clauses 2(c) and 3(b) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
 - (c) vessels departing the shore for the purposes of competing in races are excluded from the requirements of Clauses 3(a) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
3. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Goulburn Murray Water to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 49 contained in Notice No.1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Wayne Schultz, Risk Management Officer, Hindmarsh Shire Council (Waterway Manager for the Wimmera River within the Shire of Hindmarsh), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. For the periods listed in Table A the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Dimboola Rowing Regatta, is prohibited on the waters of Wimmera River in the areas detailed in Table A.

Saturday 12 November 2011	7.00 am to 7.00 pm	The waters of Wimmera River from the Wimmera Street Bridge, Dimboola, approximately 800 metres south to the Lloyd Street Bend Boat Ramp.
Sunday 13 November 2011	8.00 am to 2.00 pm	The waters of Wimmera River from the Wimmera Street Bridge, Dimboola, approximately 10.5 kilometres south to Rocky Bend.

2. Vessels associated with the Dimboola Rowing Regatta are excluded from clause 2(c) as detailed in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
3. Vessels associated with the Dimboola Rowing Regatta are excluded from clauses 2(c) and 2(d) as detailed in Schedule 68 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Hindmarsh Shire Council to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 68 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
