SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Vin Wright, Acting Regional Manager, Bays and Maritime Operations, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Local Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Between the hours of 12.00 noon and 5.00 pm on Saturday 19 November bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Geelong Gala Day and vessels operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited within the area detailed below in Table 1.

Table 1: Corio Bay Exclusion Zone

The waters bounded by:
(a) A line extending from a point on the shore 38° 08' 34.50" S, 144° 21' 51.06" E, to a buoy located in approximate position 38° 08' 34.90" S, 144° 21' 43.93" E;
(b) A line extending from a buoy located in approximate position 38° 08' 34.90" S, 144° 21' 43.93" E, to a buoy in approximate position 38° 08' 30.11" S, 144° 21' 52.84" E;
(c) A line extending from a buoy located in approximate position 38° 08' 30.11" S, 144° 21' 52.84" E, to a point on the shore 38° 08' 32.28" S, 144° 21' 52.84" E;
(d) A line extending from a point on the shore 38° 08' 32.28" S, 144° 21' 52.84" E, to a point on the shore 38° 08' 32.28" S, 144° 21' 52.84" E;
(e) A line extending from a point on the shore 38° 08' 32.28" S, 144° 21' 52.84" E, to a point on the shore 38° 08' 32.59" S; 144° 21' 52.84" E;
(f) A line extending from a point on the shore 38° 08' 32.59" S; 144° 21' 52.84" E, to a point on the shore 38° 08' 34.50" S, 144° 21' 51.06" E.

2. Vessels engaged in the Water Ski Show and vessels operated by Parks Victoria are excluded from the requirements of:
 - (a) Clause 2(a) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**;
 - (b) Clause 2(c) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**; and
 - (c) Clause 4(a) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
3. Vessels and persons involved in the presentation of the Water Ski Show are excluded from the provisions of Clause 19 (b) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Parks Victoria to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 1 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Graeme Davis, Acting Regional Manager, Bays and Maritime Operations, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. From 5.30 pm to 7.30 pm on Monday 21 and Tuesday 22 November 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Melbourne Rowing Week twilight events, vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria and vessels authorised by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River between the downstream edge of Spencer Street Bridge and the upstream edge of Sandridge Rail Bridge.
2. Vessels involved in the Melbourne Rowing Week twilight events are exempt from the 5 knot speed limit as detailed in clause 1 of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
3. Vessels involved in the Melbourne Rowing Week twilight events are excluded from the requirement to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within 50 meters of the waters edge and 50 metres of another vessel, as detailed clauses 3(a) and 2(c) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Parks Victoria to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

From 6.00 am to 2.00 pm on Saturday 19 November 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Melbourne Head rowing event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on all the waters of the Yarra River between a diagonal line from the downstream edge of the VRA landing to the upstream edge of Federation Wharf, and the upstream edge of the Monash Freeway Bridge.
2. Vessels involved in the Melbourne Head rowing event are exempt from the 5 knot speed limit as detailed in clause 1 of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
3. Vessels involved in the Melbourne Head rowing event are excluded from the requirement to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within 50 meters of the waters edge and 50 metres of another vessel, as detailed clauses 3(a) and 2(c) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Parks Victoria to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

From 10.00 am to 4.00 pm on Saturday 26 November 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Head of the Yarra rowing event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on all the waters of the Yarra River between a diagonal line from the downstream edge of the VRA landing to the upstream edge of Federation Wharf, and the Victoria Street Bridge.
2. Vessels involved in the Head of the Yarra rowing event are exempt from the 5 knot speed limit as detailed in clause 1 of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
3. Vessels involved in the Head of the Yarra rowing event are excluded from the requirement to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within 50 meters of the waters edge and 50 metres of another vessel, as detailed clauses 3(a) and 2(c) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
4. PWC vessels operated by Life Saving Victoria involved in the Head of the Yarra rowing event are excluded from the provisions of clause 3(b) in Schedule 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
5. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Parks Victoria to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
