### SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of David Lewis, Parks Officer, Lakes & Gardens Strategy, City of Ballarat (Waterway Manager for Lake Wendouree), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. From 12.30 pm to 3.15 pm on Saturday 26 November 2011 and from 8.30 am to 11.00 am on Sunday 27 November 2011, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Ballarat Triathlon Festival event, is prohibited on all the waters of Lake Wendouree in the south-western corner at the rowing basin finish.
2. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by City of Ballarat to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 42 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Geoffrey Rollinson, Director, Infrastructure Planning and Regulatory Services, Gannawarra Shire Council (Waterway Manager for Lake Charm), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.00 pm on Saturday 26 November 2011 and between 6.30 am and 7.00 pm Sunday 27 November 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels and bathers associated with the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 3, is prohibited on all of the waters of Lake Charm;
2. Vessels associated with the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 3 at Lake Charm are excluded from the provisions of Schedule 139 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event;
3. Vessels competing in the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 3 at Lake Charm are excluded from the requirements of Clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 3(b) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event;
4. Vessels competing in the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 3 at Lake Charm are exempt from the requirements of Regulation 228(3) of the Marine Regulations 2009, in respect to the requirement to carry a torch, bailer, and bucket for the duration of the event; and
5. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Gannawarra Shire Council to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 139 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Capt. Peter S. Gracias, Marine Manager/Harbour Master, Port of Portland Pty Ltd, (port management body for the Port of Portland), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

From the publication of this Section 15 Notice until further notice, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels authorised by the Port of Portland Pty Ltd is prohibited on the following waters of the Port of Portland.

- (a) An area bounded by the north-west corner of the port land boundary, to a point (1); 38°20'50.28"S, 141°36'49.48"E; then to a point (2) 38°20'51.74"S, 141°36'55.59"E; then to a point (3) 38°20'53.20"S, 141°37'2.09"E; then to the south-west corner of Berth No. 6.

Points 1, 2 and 3 are marked by Yellow buoys with a Fl. W light.

- (b) The waters north and west of a line between a point on the shore 38°20'43.83"S, 141°36'28.77"E and a point on the shore 38°20'42.45"S, 141°36'29.86"E located in the north-west area of the harbour.

## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Graeme Davis, Acting Regional Manager, Bays and Maritime Operations, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. From 8.00 am to 6.00 pm on Saturday 26 November 2011, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Australian Corporate Games Dragon Boat Championship event, vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria and vessels authorised by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River within the area detailed below in Table 1.

Table 1: Victoria Harbour Exclusion Zone

The waters bounded by:

2. Vessels providing rescue services for the Australian Corporate Games Dragon Boat Championship are exempt from the 5 knot speed limit as detailed in clause 1 of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No.1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
3. Vessels providing rescue services for the Australian Corporate Games Dragon Boat Championship are excluded from the requirement to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within 50 meters of a person in the water, another vessel, the waters edge and fixed or floating structures, as detailed clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Parks Victoria to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
