SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director, Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Chief Executive Officer, Shire of Strathbogie (the Waterway Manager for the Goulburn River between Hughes Creek and the Goulburn Weir including the waters of Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the 2011 NYE Fireworks Display, vessels operated by Strathbogie Shire Council and those vessels designated as berthed or moored by Strathbogie Shire Council, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie as detailed in Table 1.

Table 1

Date and Time	Location
5.00 pm to 9.45 pm Saturday 31 December 2011	Within 50 metres of the fireworks firing site located on the foreshore in Buckley Park, Nagambie
9.45 pm to 10.15 pm Saturday 31 December 2011	Within 150 metres of fireworks firing site located on the foreshore in Buckley Park, Nagambie

2. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by the Shire of Strathbogie to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director, Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Vin Wright, Acting Regional Manager, Bays and Maritime Operations, Parks Victoria (the Waterway Manager for the Local Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (a) between the hours of 8.00 pm Saturday 31 December 2011 and 12.30 am Sunday 1 January 2012, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the fireworks event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria is prohibited within 100 metres of a fireworks barge located in the approximate position 38° 08.410'S, 144° 21. 895'E, WGS84 (approximately 150 metres north-east of Cunningham Pier)
- (b) at the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 1 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

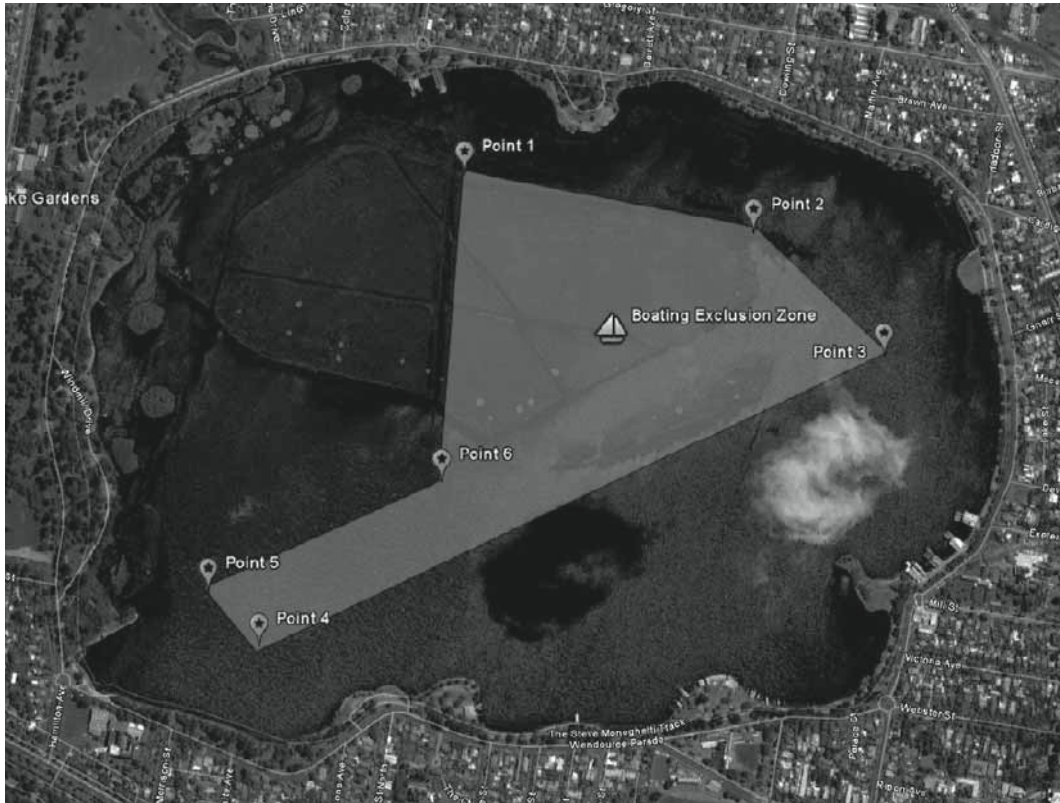
SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director, Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Bernard Blood, Curator Lake Wendouree, City of Ballarat (the Waterway Manager for Lake Wendouree), hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that from the publication of this Notice till 12.00 am Monday 30 April 2012, the waters of Lake Wendouree are subject to the following operating rules:

- (1) A speed limit of 5 knots applies to all the waters of Lake Wendouree except areas prohibited to vessels.
- (2) Bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels authorised by the City of Ballarat, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Wendouree bounded by the Geo spatially referenced points detailed in Table 1.

Point 1	37°32'45.03"S	143°49'54.72"E
Point 2	37°32'48.67"S	143°50'19.82"E
Point 3	37°32'56.99"S	143°50'31.31"E
Point 4	37°33'17.64"S	143°49'37.65"E
Point 5	37°33'13.91"S	143°49'33.17"E
Point 6	37°33'06.19"S	143°49'53.22"E



- (3) The operation of rowing vessels on Lake Wendouree is in an anti-clockwise direction around a line of yellow buoys at all times, except for rowing vessels engaged in official competition.
- (4) Powered vessels authorised by Ballarat City Council involved in rowing coaching and official rowing competition are excluded from the purposes of clause 2(a) (above) provided that powered vessels engaged in this activity display a red flag and do not exceed a speed greater than the rowing vessel being observed.
- (5) The whole of the waters of Lake Wendouree is prohibited to vessels when the water level falls below 600 mm of the overflow level of the Lake, as measured at the marker gauges located on the east side of the Lake approximately 120 metres south of Macarthur Street and on the south-west side at the end of the isthmus.
