## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director, Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Inspector Stephen Guilmartin, OIC – Water Police Squad/Search & Rescue Squad, Victoria Police, hereby give notice under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. from the publication of this Notice till 5.00 pm Saturday 31 March 2012, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) excluding those vessels involved with the Victorian Desalination Project is prohibited on the waters of Bass Strait (in the vicinity of Powlett River South Gippsland) within the waters bounded by the Latitude and Longitude points detailed in Table 1.

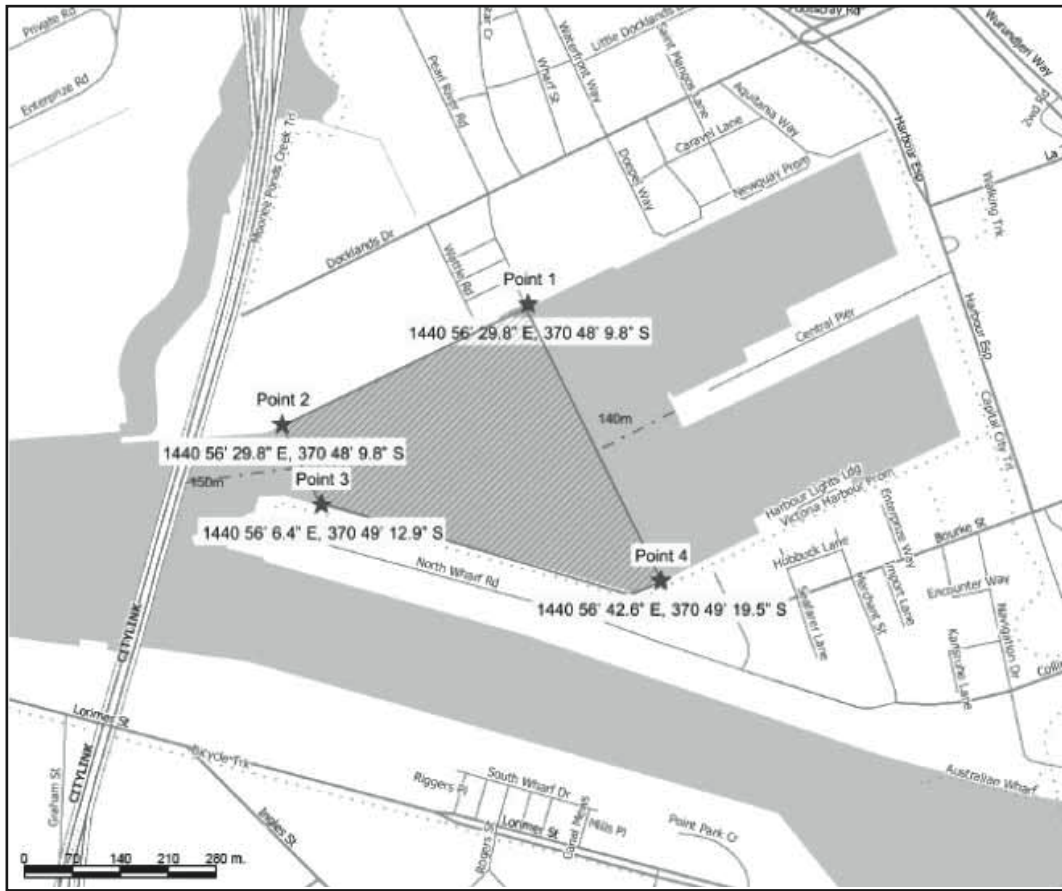
**SECTION 15 NOTICE**

I, Lisa Faldon, the Acting Director, Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Vincent Wright, Acting Regional Manager, Bays and Maritime Operations, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the fireworks event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited at the location detailed in Table 1, and for the hours from:
  - 9.00 pm to 10.00 pm Saturday 31 December 2011; and
  - 11.30 pm Saturday 31 December 2011 to 12.30 am Sunday 1 January 2012.

The waters bounded by:	
(i)	A line extending from a point on the shore 37° 48' 9.8" S, 144° 56' 29. 8" E to a point on the shore approximate position 37° 49' 7.9" S, 144° 56' 4.79" E;
(ii)	A line extending from a point on the shore 37° 49' 7.9" S, 144° 56' 4.79" E to a point on the shore 37° 49' 12.9" S, 144° 56' 6.4" E;
(iii)	A line extending from a point on the shore 37° 49' 12.9" S, 144° 56' 6.4" E to a point on the shore position 37° 49' 19.5" S, 144° 56' 42.6" E;
(iv)	A line extending from a point on the shore 37° 49' 19.5" S, 144° 56' 42.6" E to a point on the shore 37° 48' 9.8" S, 144° 56' 29. 8" E.



2. At the completion of the event and/or as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

## SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director, Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Colin McQuillen, Business Support Officer, Southern Rural Water (the Waterway Manager for Lake Glenmaggie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. From 2.00 pm Sunday 1 January 2012 to 5.00 pm Monday 2 January 2012, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels associated with the Glenmaggie and District Boat Club – Glenmaggie Gold Cup racing event, is prohibited on the waters of Lake Glenmaggie west of a line of buoys from the western point of the McAlister River Inlet to the waters edge 620 m north of Seaton Road and east of Glenmaggie Bridge.
2. Vessels competing in the Glenmaggie and District Boat Club – Glenmaggie Gold Cup racing event at Lake Glenmaggie are excluded from the requirements of Clauses 2(c) and 3(b) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event.
3. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Southern Rural Water to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 111 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
