SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Acting Senior Sergeant Adrian Sinclair, Water Police Squad (member of the Victoria Police), hereby give notice under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** that until further notice bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding Victoria Police vessels and vessels authorised by Victoria Police, is prohibited on the following waterways:

1. Kow Swamp, Gunbower;
2. Pyramid Creek downstream from the outlet at Kow Swamp, Gunbower, to the weir at Lower Loddon Road, Kerang; and
3. Lake Meran.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Director Strategic and Community Development, Strathbogie Shire Council (Waterway Manager for the Waters of the Goulburn River from Hughes Creek to the Goulburn Weir including Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. Between the hours of 8.00 am to 5.00 pm on Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 March 2011, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) excluding:
 - (a) vessels and persons involved in the NOW Festival events; and
 - (b) vessels operated by Strathbogie Shire Council;is prohibited on all the waters of Lake Nagambie extending:
 - (a) south and east of an imaginary line commencing at Huttons Point; and

SPECIAL

- (b) westerly to the 500m mark of the rowing course located within the 'un-powered boating zone' described in Item 14 of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**; and
 - (c) southerly to the shore.
2. For the area and times detailed above, vessels and persons involved in the NOW Festival events are excluded from the requirements of Clauses 10(a), 11 and 14 of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
 3. At the completion of the events or at a time determined by Strathbogie Shire Council to enable the completion of events, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
