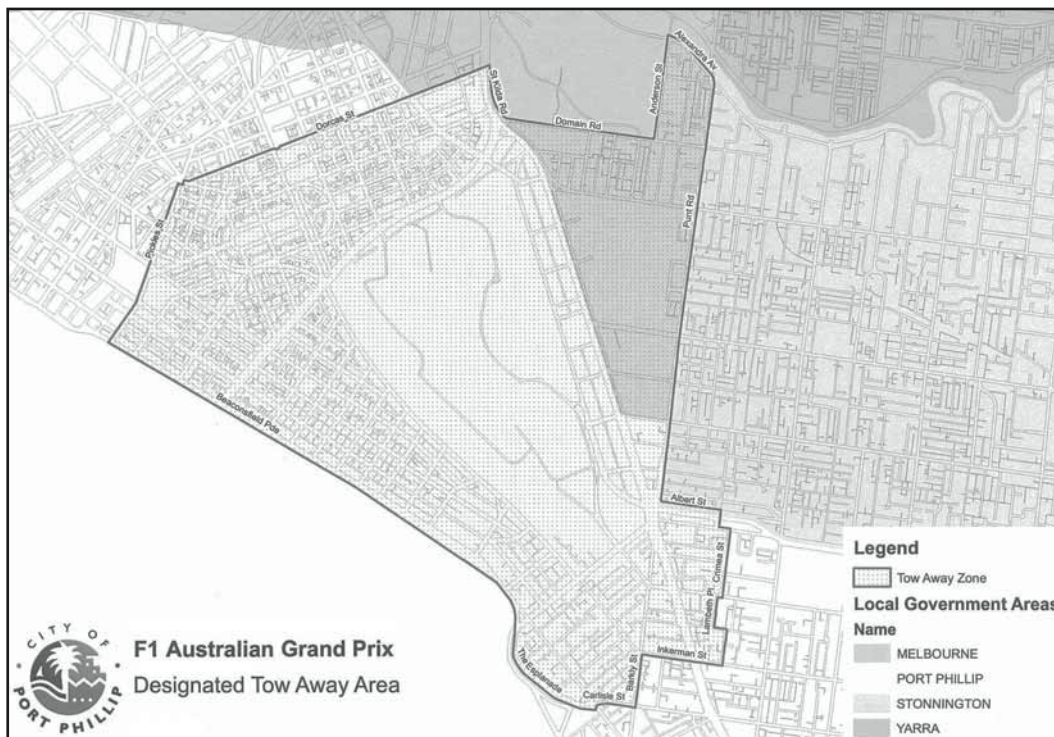
### SCHEDULE 11 CLAUSE 4

#### Designation of Tow Away Areas

Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989** provides that a Council may move or impound any vehicle that is causing an unlawful obstruction, or that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a fee up to the amount of the fee set for the purposes of clause 3(1)(c).

For the purposes of that provision, I, Terry Mulder, Minister for Roads, designate the area depicted within the boundary line on the plan attached to this Schedule, including all parts of the roads on the perimeter of that area, to be a tow away area.

This instrument takes effect at 12.01 am on Thursday 24 March 2011 and expires at 11.59 pm on Sunday 27 March 2011.

## DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4)

**1. Declaration**

I, Garry Liddle, Chief Executive VicRoads, acting under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and on the application of Australian Grand Prix Corporation, declare that the provisions of the Road Safety Road Rules 2009 specified in Schedule I do not apply to the non-road activity specified in column 1 of schedule 2 conducted on the highways specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 during the period specified in column 3 of Schedule 2 and are subject to the conditions set out in this declaration.

**2. Conditions**

This exemption is subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) The owner of the land on which the non-road activity is to be conducted must have consented to that activity.
- (2) The highway used for the non-road activity must be closed to traffic
- (3) Except the provisions exempted by this notice and as set out in Schedule 1, all relevant safety requirements must be complied with including (without limitation) all provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986**, the Road Safety Road Rules 2009, the **Road Management Act 2004** and the **Occupational Health and Safety Act 2004** and any regulations made under those Acts.
- (4) A copy of this notice must be produced on demand to any member of the police force or to any person who is an authorised officer under section 71 of the **Road Management Act 2004**.
- (5) Failure to comply with a condition specified in paragraph 2 does not invalidate the exemption given by this Notice.

**Schedule 1**

<b>Provisions of Road Safety Road Rules 2009 to which this exemption applies</b>	
Rule 99(1)	A driver driving past a keep left sign must drive to the left of the sign
Rule 100	No entry signs
Rule 130	Keeping to the left on a multi-lane road
Rule 146	Driving within a single marked lane or line of traffic
Rule 147	Moving from one marked lane to another marked lane across a continuous line separating the lanes
Rule 177	Stopping on a freeway
Rule 178	Stopping in an emergency stopping lane
Rule 291	Making any unnecessary noise
