Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983

CONDITIONS UNDER SECTION 220D

I, Norman Gray, Director of Public Transport, pursuant to section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983**, hereby determine and publish in the Government Gazette the following conditions (the amending conditions) which amend the conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** contained in the Victorian Fares and Ticketing Manual (General) (effective 12 March 2011) published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 77 dated Thursday 10 March 2011.

The amending conditions take effect from and including 20 April 2011.

AMENDING CONDITIONS

The conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** contained in the Victorian Fares and Ticketing Manual (General) (effective 12 March 2011) published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 77 dated Thursday 10 March 2011 (the General Manual) are amended as follows.

The amendments made by these amending conditions apply in respect of entitlements to use a public transport service that are subject to the conditions contained in the General Manual and that are able to be exercised on or after the commencement of these amending conditions, including entitlements that existed, but had not been exercised, before these amending conditions were published in the Government Gazette.

In Chapter 8 of the General Manual, under the heading '**Animals**', for the paragraph under the heading '**V/Line services**' substitute –

'Animals are not permitted to travel on V/Line coach services (including rail replacement coach services) with the exception of guide dogs, hearing guide dogs, guide dogs in training or an animal identified on an Assistance Animal Pass (see page 60).

Animals are only permitted to travel on V/Line train services as set out in the following paragraphs.

Guide dogs, hearing guide dogs, guide dogs in training and an animal identified on an Assistance Animal Pass are permitted to travel on all V/Line train services (see page 60).

Small animals are permitted to travel on all V/Line train services, but they must be in a suitable container.

Dogs (other than dogs referred to above) are permitted to travel on V/Line train services that begin and end at railway stations between and including Southern Cross Station and, respectively, Traralgon, Seymour, Eaglehawk, Wendouree or Marshall.

The dogs must be on leads and muzzled.

It is strongly advised that passengers with dogs do not travel during weekdays between 7.00 am and 9.00 am and between 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm.

Dogs are not allowed on seats, are not allowed to block doorways or passageways and must be controlled by their owner at all times.

Owners must clean up any mess created by their dogs.'
