SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director, Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Steve Crawcour, Acting Chief Executive Officer, Strathbogie Shire Council (Waterway Manager for the waters of the Goulburn River from Hughes Creek to the Goulburn Weir including Lake Nagambie), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. From 7.00 am to 8.00 pm on Saturday 21 May 2011, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie south-east of an imaginary line between the water's edge adjacent to the prolongation of Racecourse Road and the northern point of Vickers Island, excluding:
 - (a) vessels involved with the Masters State Rowing Championship Regatta;
 - (b) vessels operated by the Strathbogie Shire Council;
 - (c) vessels launching from and returning to the Nagambie Lakes Leisure Park boat ramp and adjacent foreshore providing that they do not exceed 5 knots and travel directly to and from the Goulburn River entrance north of Vickers Island, keeping to the west of Dellah Island;
 - (d) vessels travelling to and from the Goulburn River from Willow Cove and passing under the Scour Bridge providing that they do not exceed 5 knots; and
 - (e) vessels travelling to and from the Goulburn River from residential properties along the north-eastern shoreline of Lake Nagambie north of a prolongation of Young Street providing that they do not exceed 5 knots and remain within 30 metres of the water's edge and as marked by transit buoys.
2. Vessels involved with the event above are excluded from the '5 knot speed limits' and 'No Boating Zone' contained in Items 10(a) & (b) and 12(a) of Schedule 91 respectively.
3. During the closure period competitors' rowing vessels are prohibited from the waters of the Goulburn River.
4. At the completion of the event, or at a time determined by Strathbogie Shire Council to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 91 contained in Notice No.1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

I, Lisa Faldon, the Director, Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Adrian Sinclair, Acting Senior Sergeant, Water Police Squad – Search and Rescue Squad, hereby give notice under Section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

- till 5.00 pm Saturday 31 December 2011 bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding those vessels involved with the Victorian Desalination Project, is prohibited on the waters of Bass Strait (in the vicinity of Powlett River South Gippsland) within the waters bounded by the Latitude and Longitude points detailed in Table 1;
