ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION (INDUSTRIAL WASTE RESOURCE) REGULATIONS 2009

Prescribed Industrial Waste – Contaminated Soil – Classification with Management Options

The Environment Protection Authority ('the Authority'), under regulation 11(7) of the Environment Protection (Industrial Waste Resource) Regulations 2009 ('the Regulations'), hereby issues the following classification that determines the management options for the off-site use of contaminated soil.

1. Classification Number

1.1 This classification can be cited as Classification No. 2011/018.

2. Definitions

2.1 In this classification:

contaminated soil means soil or a mixture of soils that can be classified as Category A, B or C Contaminated Soil as provided for under the Regulations and defined in the Industrial Waste Guidelines (published in Special Gazette No. S177 on 9 June 2009);

off-site means a site other than the site at which the contaminant(s) entered the soil.

3. Commencement

3.1 This classification comes into operation on 1 July 2011 and remains in operation until revoked by the Authority.

4. Conditions of Classification – management options

4.1 Except as provided for under clause 4.2, the only off-site management options for contaminated soil are:

- (a) treatment, to remove, beneficially re-use or destroy any or all contaminants, at a site licensed or authorised by the Authority; or
- (b) where such treatment is not available, disposal at a site licensed by the Authority to accept that contaminated soil.

4.2 Clause 4.1 does not apply if the contaminated soil is managed in accordance with:

- (a) a notifiable chemical order made under section 30D of the Act, if a contaminant is a chemical covered by the order; or
- (b) the 'Industrial Waste Management Policy (Waste Acid Sulfate Soils) 1999', if the soil is an acid sulfate soil.
