Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983

CONDITIONS UNDER SECTION 220D

I, Hector McKenzie, Director of Public Transport, pursuant to section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983**, hereby determine and publish in the Government Gazette the following conditions (the amending conditions) which amend the conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** contained in the Victorian Fares and Ticketing Manual (General) (effective 12 March 2011) published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S77 dated Thursday 10 March 2011 as amended by the conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S131 dated Wednesday 20 April 2011.

The amending conditions take effect from and including 1 July 2011.

AMENDING CONDITIONS

The conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** contained in the Victorian Fares and Ticketing Manual (General) (effective 12 March 2011) published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S77 dated Thursday 10 March 2011 (the General Manual) as amended by the conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S131 dated Wednesday 20 April 2011 (the First Amending Conditions) are amended as follows.

In these amending conditions, after this paragraph, a reference to the General Manual is a reference to the conditions contained in the General Manual as amended by the First Amending Conditions.

The amendments made by these amending conditions apply in respect of entitlements to use a public transport service that are subject to the conditions contained in the General Manual and that are able to be exercised on or after the commencement of these amending conditions, including entitlements that existed, but had not been exercised, before these amending conditions were published in the Government Gazette.

In Chapter 2 of the General Manual, under the heading '**Melbourne bus zones**', in the paragraph beginning 'The following bus routes are entirely within Zone 1'—

- (a) **delete** '525'; and
- (b) in its correct numerical position **insert** '505'.

In Chapter 2 of the General Manual, for the table referred to in the last paragraph under the heading 'Where to buy Metcards', substitute –

All Metcard retail agents are required to stock 2-hour, Daily, 10 x 2-hour, 5 x Daily, Weekly and Monthly Metcards for zones 1, 2 and 1+2.

They are also required to stock sunday saver, seniors daily, 5 x Seniors Daily Metcards and 5 x Weekend Daily Metcards.

In Chapter 2 of the General Manual, under the heading ‘**Metropolitan bus routes extending outside the Melbourne metropolitan area**’, in the table immediately following ‘The routes listed below extend beyond zones 1 and 2. Most of these routes include zone overlaps.’, for the row commencing ‘683’ **substitute** –

683	Zone 2 applies along the entire route. Zone 3 applies east of Allsops Road / Wickham Road (Woori Yallock).

In Chapter 6 of the General Manual, under the heading ‘**Concession Cards**’, for the four paragraphs under the heading ‘**Victorian Public Transport Student Concession Card**’ **substitute** –

‘Concession cards and application forms (for codes P, S and T) are available from metropolitan premium stations, staffed V/Line stations and The MetShop. Application forms are also available from Metlink by phoning **131 638** and from **metlinkmelbourne.com.au**.

Student identification cards issued by schools and tertiary institutions are not accepted for concession travel on public transport.

Students who are Australian Citizens or permanent residents of Australia are eligible. Overseas exchange students, students with refugee status or students in receipt of an Australian Development Scholarship are also eligible if they provide proof of their eligibility (letter from their institution) when applying for the Victorian Public Transport Student Concession Card. All other students are not eligible for student concessions.’

In Chapter 9 of the General Manual, under the heading ‘**Lost or stolen tickets**’–

(a) in the second paragraph under the heading ‘**Metcard**’, for ‘\$12.00’ **substitute** ‘\$9.80’; and

(b) in the second paragraph under the heading ‘**V/Line**’, for \$12.00’ **substitute** ‘\$9.80’.

In Chapter 9 of the General Manual, under the heading ‘**Refund procedures**’ in the first paragraph under the heading ‘**Metcard**’, after ‘but only one reason is allowed per claim.’ **insert** ‘Any Metcard(s) submitted for refund cannot be returned after the application is processed.’
