## Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983

### CONDITIONS UNDER SECTION 220D

I, Hector McKenzie, Director of Public Transport, pursuant to section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983**, hereby determine and publish in the Government Gazette the following conditions (the amending conditions) which amend the conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** contained in the Victorian Fares and Ticketing Manual (General) (effective 12 March 2011) published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 77 dated Thursday 10 March 2011 as amended by the conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 131 dated Wednesday 20 April 2011 and the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 210 dated Thursday 30 June 2011.

The amending conditions take effect from and including 25 July 2011.

### AMENDING CONDITIONS

The conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** contained in the Victorian Fares and Ticketing Manual (General) (effective 12 March 2011) published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 77 dated Thursday 10 March 2011 (the General Manual) as amended by the conditions under section 220D of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 131 dated Wednesday 20 April 2011 and the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 210 dated Thursday 30 June 2011 (respectively the First Amending Conditions and the Second Amending Conditions), are amended as follows.

In these amending conditions, after this paragraph, a reference to the General Manual is a reference to the conditions contained in the General Manual as amended by the First Amending Conditions and the Second Amending conditions.

The amendments made by these amending conditions apply in respect of entitlements to use a public transport service that are subject to the conditions contained in the General Manual and that are able to be exercised on or after the commencement of these amending conditions, including entitlements that existed, but had not been exercised, before these amending conditions were published in the Government Gazette.

In Chapter 2 of the General Manual, under the heading ‘**Melbourne bus zones**’, in the paragraph beginning ‘The following bus routes are entirely within the overlap between zones 1 and 2:’, in its correct numerical position **insert** ‘, 601’.

In Chapter 2 of the General Manual, under the heading ‘**Melbourne bus zones**’, in the table immediately following ‘The following bus routes are within Zone 2, but overlap with Zone 1 on the portion of the route indicated:’ –

- (a) in the row commencing ‘556’, for ‘Gladstone Street (Reservoir)’ **substitute** ‘White Street and McMahon Road (Reservoir)’; and
- (b) **delete** the row commencing ‘561’.

In Chapter 2 of the General Manual, under the heading ‘**Melbourne bus zones**’, in the table immediately following ‘Parts of the following bus routes are within Zone 1 and parts are within Zone 2 as indicated. Note that most of the following routes include zone overlaps of Zones 1 and 2:’ –

**SPECIAL**

- (a) in the row commencing ‘552’, for ‘Evans Crescent (Reservoir) **substitute** ‘McMahon Road (Reservoir)’; and
- (b) after the row commencing ‘552’ **insert** –

561           | Zone 1 applies for all stops along route west of Grieve Street (Macleod West).  
                   | Zone 2 applies for all stops along route north-east of Carawa Drive (Coburg North).’,

In Chapter 2 of the General Manual, for the fifth paragraph under the heading ‘**Pre-pay Bus Stops and Bus Routes**’ **substitute** –

‘The following bus routes are specified as pre-pay bus routes:

- Metropolitan bus route number 401
- Metropolitan bus route number 601.’.

In chapter 8 of the General Manual, under the heading ‘**Animals**’, for the last six paragraphs (including the advisory paragraph) under the heading ‘**V/Line Services**’ **substitute** –

‘Small animals are permitted to travel on all V/Line train services, but they must be in a suitable container.

Suitable containers must be stored in the assigned storage locations on board each train and are not allowed on seats or to block doorways or passageways.

**It is strongly advised that passengers with small animals in suitable containers do not travel during weekdays between 7.00 am and 9.00 am and between 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm.**

Owners must clean up any mess created by their animals.’.
